A Look at How Your Gifts Can Help

Gettysburg Hospital Foundation is dedicated to supporting the health and wellness needs of our neighbors through various community benefit programs:

Cancer Patient Help Fund

The Cancer Patient Help Fund alleviates the financial burden on individuals and families undergoing cancer treatment by assisting with basic living expenses such as rent, utilities, groceries, and transportation. You are lifting some of the burdens during a time when patients and their families need it the most, allowing them to focus on their health and treatment.

Research shows that a patient’s ability to heal is significantly affected by the stability of their environment.

Gifts to the Cancer Patient Help Fund make a direct and immediate impact on patients who are struggling with basic needs as they undergo cancer treatments.

- A \$50 donation provides gift cards to help patients and their families with grocery bills.
- A gift of \$75 provides financial assistance for monthly utility bills to ensure a safe, stable environment for our patients.
- A contribution of \$100 provides 25 bus rides or four \$25 gas cards to help patients get to and from their doctor appointments.

Every penny of every gift is directed locally to help patients and their families in Adams County and northern Maryland, allowing them to focus on their health and treatments.



Last fiscal year the Adams County Cancer Patient Help Fund provided over

\$250,000

to **80 patients** and their families.

Patient Support Fund

Relieves the financial pressures on patients who have needs that impact their treatment or health outcomes. This fund helps at-risk patients with food, transportation, transitional housing and life-saving medications.



Durable Medical Equipment

- Help patients receive equipment so they can recover at home.
- **\$300 helps** one patient with a month of oxygen.



Food Insecurity

- Nearly **600 patients** have been identified as food insecure.
- **\$50 provides** a 3-day supply of meals for a food insecure patient upon discharge from the hospital.



Medication Assistance

- Helping an average of **80 patients** per month obtain life-saving medication.
- **\$100 helps** two patients afford their medication each month.



Transportation Access

- **\$25 helps** a patient get home from the hospital or to their follow up appointment.

Linda’s Fund

Linda’s Fund provides in-home, private-duty care for oncology patients who need assistance with activities of daily living while undergoing treatment. This fund was established in memory of Linda Kranias, who passed away from breast cancer. You are helping patients receive support as they recover at home.

Gettysburg Hospital Foundation Internal Grant Program

Gettysburg Hospital Foundation Internal Grant Program supports various needs at WellSpan Gettysburg Hospital and WellSpan practices in Adams County as they provide quality care and excellence in patient experience. Grant awards must meet the Gettysburg Hospital Foundation’s priorities of exceptional health outcomes, a thriving healthcare workforce, and vibrant, healthy communities.

Celebrating 40 years of Benefiting our Community in 2025

Over the years, many local businesses and other companies supported various beneficiaries in Adams County and northern Maryland through corporate partnerships to help our neighbors meet their health goals and receive needed care. Here's how previous giving made an impact in our community:



Children's Health Fund Over \$730,000

The Children's Health Fund provided services for children in the community like free dental care services, medication assistance, sleep sacks for newborns, car seat distribution, medical examinations to child victims of sexual abuse as part of the SAFE program, and free, early child physical health screenings.



Prescription for Caring Over \$230,000

Prescription for Caring, a program of the Patient Support Fund, provides vital medications to people who can't afford their prescriptions due to the lack of insurance or high deductibles.



Adams Mammography Help Fund Over \$76,000

The Adams Mammography Help Fund provides free mammograms to women who don't have insurance or have high insurance deductibles. This fund helps relieve the financial burden of baseline screenings for women age 40 and over who need financial assistance.



Patient Experience Fund Over \$70,000

The Patient Experience Fund supports projects that are part of the hospital's ongoing commitment to excellence for the patient-family centered experience in promoting hope, healing, and hospitality.

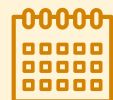
