

What Iceland is Known For!

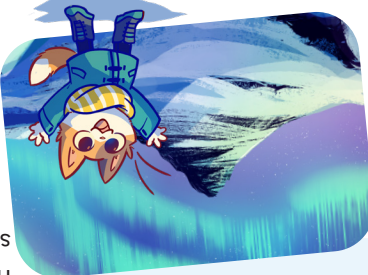
Glaciers: These are huge, slow-moving rivers of ice. They're super cool (literally!).

English	Icelandic	Phonetic (How To Say)
Hello.....	Halló.....	(ha-LO)
Goodbye.....	Bless.....	(BLESS)
Thank You.....	Takk.....	(TAKK)
Good Morning.....	Gódan daginn.....	(GO-than DA-gin)
Good Afternoon.....	Gott kvöld.....	(GOT KUH-vuhld)
