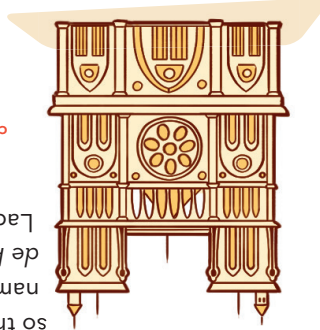

Paris is the capital city of France. It is sometimes known as "The City of Light" - it began using street lights before most other European cities!

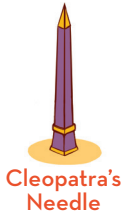
