- The Amazon Rainforest in South America

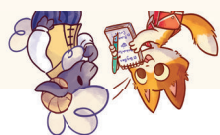
## Famous examples:

**What you can see:** People speaking different languages and using different writing systems

**Where to find it:** Cultural festivals or international neighborhoods in your city

**What you can do:**

- Learn to say "hello" and "thank you" in different languages
- Taste foods from different cultures and describe them
- Learn a traditional dance or game from another culture

- Chinatown in San Francisco, USA
- Little Italy in many major cities



## History Class at Landmarks

**What you can see:** Cool old buildings, monuments, and sites where important events happened

**Where to find it:** Historical sites or old neighborhoods in your town

## What you can do:

- Create a timeline of events that happened at the site

- Read about or dress up as a historical figure from that time period
- Write a diary entry as if you lived during that time
- Compare old photos of the site to how it looks now

## Famous examples:

- The Colosseum in Rome, Italy
- Independence Hall in Philadelphia, USA
- The Taj Mahal in Agra, India
- Machu Picchu in Peru
- The Acropolis in Athens, Greece

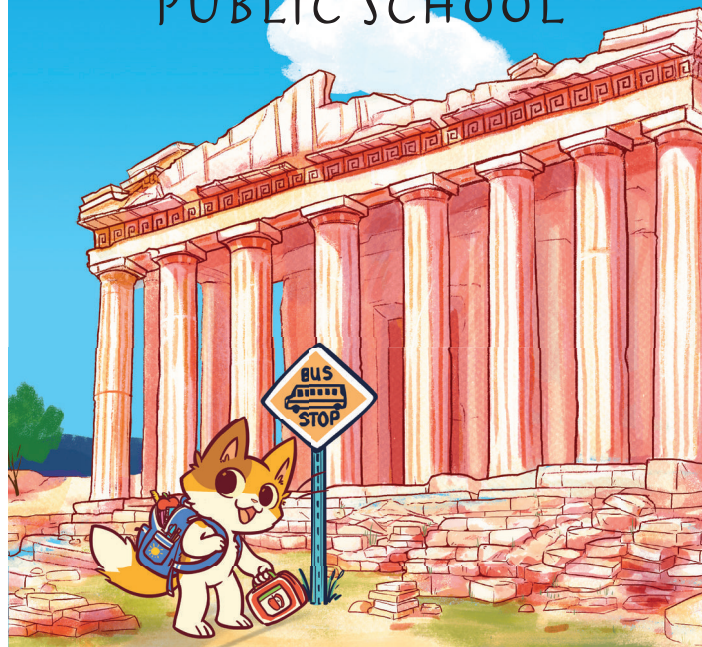
