



AUTO ACCIDENT CHECKLIST

When you've been in a car accident, it's easy to feel overwhelmed. That's why we've put together a list to help you navigate the aftermath of an accident and make sure your situation gets handled as smoothly and safely as possible.

- REMAIN CALM**
Take a few deep breaths and make sure everyone is all right.
If possible, turn on your hazard lights and move out of traffic.

- CALL LOCAL AUTHORITIES**
If someone is hurt, call 911 immediately. If no one is injured, call the local police department's non-emergency phone number.

- COLLECT INFORMATION**
If other vehicles were involved in the accident, collect the following information:
 - Names and contact information of everyone involved
 - Vehicle description (year, make and model)
 - Insurance information, including policy number
 - Witness names and contact information
 - If you feel unsafe gathering any of this information, wait for the police to arrive.
Do not discuss fault or your insurance coverage.

- DOCUMENT EVERYTHING**
Take photos of the license plates of everyone involved, any damage to all vehicles, street names, road conditions and any property damage.
