
Miles My Way Odometer Photo Tips





Tips for capturing an acceptable photo:

- 1. Ensure your odometer number fills the entire photo taking box
- 2. Use the zoom buttons to enlarge your odometer number within the box
- 3. Only capture your odometer number, not including trip mileage









If your photo cannot be read on your third attempt, you may choose to submit your photo for manual review.

Note: If our support team cannot read the odometer photo, we will reach back out to you for a new photo.

Common issues you may experience with your device

- 1 Enable auto-rotate or disable portrait orientation lock
 - · If you are having difficulty using landscape orientation with your camera, you may need to enable auto-rotate on your phone.
 - Follow these instructions for help:
 - o iOS Devices: Rotate the screen on your iPhone or iPod touch Apple Support
 - Android Devices: Swipe down on your phone and select the icon to enable auto rotate. Also see the following:

- 2 Browser camera access
 - To capture images and submit them with the Odometer Photo Capture web app, you must enable camera access on your mobile device.
 - iOS Devices: To enable camera access from the system Settings:
 Go to Settings > Privacy > Camera. You should see a list of all apps that have requested access to the camera.
 - 1. Turn on camera access for your browser.
 - Android Devices: To enable camera access from the System Settings, go to Change Permissions for apps on your Android phone in the Android help and follow the steps provided.
- 3 If the photo odometer web capture does not open correctly, you may need to close your browser and re-open
