Hao Ren Hao Shi Limited is a registered charity with a mission to improve the lives of low-income families by providing essential supplies and provisions, while also promoting the spirit of volunteerism amongst youth, families, and communities. In April 2018, Hao Ren Hao Shi (HRHS) collaborated with Apex Clubs of Singapore to initiate grocery distribution to needy families at Redhill Close, marking the organisation's founding.

Founded by Mr Anson Ng, HRHS is managed and supported by a dedicated group of passionate volunteers. In 2022, Mr Ng's philanthropic efforts garnered him the distinguished accolade of The Straits Times Singaporean of the Year, as his compassionate actions brought about positive change for those in need.

Since 2022, HRHS has formed a valuable partnership with Dover Park Hospice (DPH), focusing on supplying provisions and consumables to patients in need during their end-of-life journey. This partnership plays a vital role in offering crucial support to these individuals during their challenging and difficult times. In addition to providing physical provisions, HRHS also regularly befriends these patients, offering as much support as possible. This holistic approach ensures that not only their physical needs are met, but also supports their mental and social well-being, which greatly complements the efforts of DPH's dedicated staff.

Working with the community, they provide support to low-income families, people with disabilities, and those in need. This includes students under the Ministry of Education's Financial Assistance Scheme (FAS), low-income families referred to by the Ministry of Social and Family Development (MSF), and inmates' families referred to by the Prison Fellowship.

Apart from mobile groceries, HRHS has also set up a mini mart at Stirling Road, where identified families in need can choose from a selection of groceries. This not only provides convenience, but also lets seniors select from a range of nutritious foods they enjoy.

Mr Ng's advice for those interested in positively impacting their community is to choose charity work that aligns with their interests and passions. He shared that one can contribute skills, knowledge, and expertise, making efforts more fulfilling and increasing the likelihood of creating meaningful and sustainable change.
