New Creation Community Services (NCCS) is a social arm of New Creation Church. Since the inception of the church in 1984, New Creation Church has been involved in helping the less privileged in the community regardless of race, language or religion. In 2023, New Creation Church established NCCS as its official social service arm to deepen and create permanence in its community work.

Beyond its "GraceCare" befriending and grocery distribution programme, NCCS actively collaborates with social service agencies and nursing homes to engage seniors. NCCS volunteers have been invaluable in supporting seniors through the "Buddying and Befriending" (BnB) programme. As Singapore's elderly population grows and the number of socially isolated seniors rises, NCCS remains committed to building meaningful relationships with seniors and alleviating loneliness within the community.

Additionally, NCCS organises outings, birthday celebrations and distributes groceries on a regular basis to the seniors. It also runs an annual initiative called "Gift of Love", which blesses the community during the Christmas season. Originally started by New Creation Church, the project is now led by NCCS and has reached more than 80,000 beneficiaries to date.

Through its programmes, NCCS seeks to fulfil its mission of loving people, one at a time.
