Established in 1927 as a one-man business, Woh Hup has grown to be one of Singapore’s largest construction and civil engineering companies. The company specialises in construction projects including residential developments, commercial buildings, industrial facilities, and infrastructure projects, and has played a significant role in shaping Singapore's skyline.

Woh Hup firmly believes in doing its part to help the community in need, not just through monetary and in-kind donations, but also by inculcating the joy of giving among its staff through volunteering activities.

One of its anchor initiatives is the "Project Completion Charity Dinners", which began more than a decade ago. A Charity Dinner is held to celebrate the successful completion of a project, with funds raised going towards selected charity organisations. Together with their business partners, Woh Hup has raised close to \$2.5 million through 32 charity dinners.

Another initiative that Woh Hup started in 2012 is the biannual lunch for seniors. In 2023, more than 150 seniors from various nursing homes and active ageing centres were invited to their biannual lunch.

Woh Hup supported the “NKF Swing For Hope: Charity Golf & Dinner” in 2022 and “Race Inspired!” in 2023, with proceeds used to subsidise treatment and provide holistic care for NKF’s patients. Their volunteers also took time off to pack medical items and befriend senior patients at the NKF Integrated Renal Centre.
