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Social services stalwart Ms Anita Fam to succeed Dr Gerard Ee as Chairperson of AIC

The Agency for Integrated Care (AIC) today announced the appointment of Ms Anita Fam as Chairperson of its Board with effect from 1 September 2026. Ms Fam will take over from Dr Gerard Ee, who has served as AIC Chairman since 2018.

2. Dr Ee was first appointed as Deputy Chairman of AIC on 1 September 2017 and assumed the role of Chairman a year later. Dr Ee has held numerous leadership appointments in various public roles, including President of the National Council of Social Service, and Chairman of the Public Transport Council. In recognition of his significant contributions to Singapore, he was awarded the Public Service Medal (PBM) in 1993, the Public Service Star (BBM) in 2003, the Meritorious Service Medal (PJG) in 2007, and the Distinguished Service Order (DSO) in 2019.

3. During Dr Ee's tenure as Chairman, AIC grew significantly in both scope and impact to meet the evolving needs of Singapore's ageing population. Under his stewardship, AIC expanded its focus beyond care coordination to include preventive health and initiatives to enhance primary and community care. The merger of the Pioneer Generation Office into AIC in 2018 further enhanced the organisation's capability to identify seniors in need and connect them to appropriate care services and government schemes. Dr Ee was also instrumental in strengthening the collective leadership and people management culture of the organisation.

A former lawyer and now full-time volunteer, Ms Fam brings more than 30 years of leadership experience in the social, healthcare and community sectors. She is the immediate past President and Chairman of the National Council of Social Service (2018 to 2026), where she strengthened sector capabilities and advanced greater collaboration and innovation across the social service sector. In addition to her new appointment at AIC, Ms Fam currently chairs the Board of Visiting Justices, the Board of Inspection and the Lien Centre for Palliative Care. She also serves as Deputy Chairman of the National Gallery Singapore, Governor of the Lien Foundation and Trustee of the Community Capability Trust. In recognition of her contributions, she was awarded the Ministry of Social and Family Development's Lifetime Achievement Award and the President's Volunteerism & Philanthropy Award in 2025. She has also received The Meritorious Service Medal at the 2026 National Day Awards.

5. AIC extends its deepest appreciation to Dr Ee for his outstanding leadership, unwavering dedication, and invaluable contributions. His vision and commitment have steered AIC through a period of significant growth and transformation, leaving an enduring legacy on the community care sector. We wish him every success in his future endeavours.
