HOUSE RULES



RULES

- 1. In all jackpot eligible tournaments, \$3 is withheld for the jackpot.
- 2. Guests are eligible to win jackpot progressive money and/or promotional prizes and jackpots ONLY while playing in eligible jackpot tournaments.
- 3. Points to be distributed will be based on the prize pool payout scale. The number of spots to be awarded points will not change in the event of a chop. In the event of a chop see Rules #4 & #7.
- 4. For events that pay out more than the point scale above, one point will be awarded to all players that cash. Points will not be awarded to anyone that finishes outside of the money.
- 5. For multi-flight tournaments, all players that make the money on day 2 will receive at least 5 points. Point distribution will follow the scale. This does not apply to the Live! Cup, see Rule 6 for those rules.
- 6. Players playing the Live! Cup at the Maryland property are eligible for the leaderboard. Those players that cash either Day 1 or Day 2 of the Live! Cup will be awarded 5 points., regardless of finishing position. Players may play and cash multiple Maryland flights and will receive 5 points for each cash.
- 7. Players will receive points based on finishing position in all cash entry poker tournaments with the exception of satellites, seniors/ladies events, or any tournament series run by an entity other than Live! Casino & Hotel.
- 8. Players who chop the prize pool proportional to chip stacks will receive the points for the place they finish based on stack size, regardless of payout amount. Players who chop the prize pool evenly will evenly chop the relevant points.
- 9. The prize for finishing in the top 50 of the Leaderboard is a \$300 entry into the \$15,000 Freeroll Tournament on Sunday, December 7 at 11:15AM. Tickets are non-transferable and non-refundable. 100% of the entry fee goes to the prize pool.
- 10. Tickets for the \$15,000 Freeroll are limited to the top 50 finishers of the November Tournament Leaderboard.
- 11. Finishing position in the Leaderboard dictates starting stack. Finishers in the top 15 get a starting stack of 20,000 units, 16-30 finishers start with 15,000 units, and 31-50 start with 10,000 units. In case of a tie between thresholds, the tied players both will start with the larger stack, i.e. 15th and 16th tie, they both start with 20,000.
- 12. In the event of a tie for the final payouts, i.e. 50th place and 51st place, both players will receive an entry ticket to the freeroll and start with 10,000 units. In situations such as this, the prize pool will not increase by an additional \$300. The value of the entry tickets will decrease so total prize pool remains \$15,000.
- 13. An optional \$20 staff add-on is available. For \$20, we will double your starting stack. Players must purchase this add-on before taking their first hand.
- 14. Leaderboard prizes will be funded from the tournament jackpot reserve.
- 15. Winners must be 21 years or older and must provide a valid picture I.D. All State and Federal taxes will be withheld from winners in accordance with State and Federal guidelines.
- 16. Management reserves the right to alter or cancel this promotion.
- 17. Tournaments included are from November 1-30, 2025.
