Four Card Poker®

Features heads up play against the dealer and an optional bonus bet.

RANKING OF HANDS

Four-of-a-Kind, Straight Flush, Three-of-a-Kind, Flush, Straight, Two Pair, Pair and High card.

GETTING STARTED

Make an Ante bet to play against the dealer. Make an Aces Up® bet to play against the bonus payable. You will then receive five cards to make your best four card poker hand. Four card Straights are Straights, four card Flushes are Flushes, etc. The dealer receives six cards and turns his top card face-up.

DECISION TIME

After looking at your hand, you have a choice: fold or bet 1x to 3x your Ante.

WINNING AND LOSING

The dealer then reveals his cards and announces his four card poker hand. If your hand beats or ties the dealer's, your Ante and Play bets win even money. If your hand loses to the dealer, your Ante and Play bets lose.

AUTOMATIC BONUSES

The top three hands in the game (Four-of-a-Kind, Straight Flush and Three-of-a-Kind) receive automatic bonuses, paid on the Ante. You receive these bonuses even if you lose to the dealer.

HAND	PAYS
Four of a Kind	25 to 1
Straight Flush	20 to 1
Three of a Kind	2 to 1

*Automatic Bonuses Paid on Ante Wager

ACES UP

The Aces Up side bet pays if your hand is a pair of Aces or better. The Aces Up bonus always pays, even if the dealer has a better hand. The higher your hand, the more you win.

HAND	PAYS
Four of a Kind	50 to 1
Straight Flush	30 to 1
Three of a Kind	7 to 1
Flush	6 to 1
Straight	5 to 1
Two Pair	2 to 1
Pair of Aces	1 to 1



PROGRESSIVE RULES OF PLAY

1. Four Card Poker Progressive is an optional progressive side bet.
2. The bet considers the best hand possible among all 5 cards dealt to the player, not just the player's 4 card hand that is in play.
3. The paytables shown have been designed to work on a link with different games all linked together. These paytables all define a 5-card winning hand from a standard 52 card deck.
