Wait time for 1st appt. for *new* patient: Roughly 1-2 months for new patients

Average duration of appt.: 60 minutes

What to bring to appt.: Form of ID, Insurance Card, Form of Payment

COMMON QUESTIONS

Is parking free? No, parking is about \$7.

Handicap accessibility? Yes, there are ramps to all entrances, along with staff at the entrance to assist.

Public transit? There are multiple bus stops nearby.

Travel tips? None.

Visit types offered? Both in-office and virtual visits are available to patients.

Scheduling options? Patients may schedule appointments by email or through an online portal.

Can a caregiver attend appt.? Yes, caregivers may attend appointment.

Non-English-speaking staff? Yes, have Spanish-speaking staff on site.

Interpreters available? We also have access to translators for most languages available with adequate forewarning
