# **Practice and Staff Registration for Referring Dementia Practices**

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### **Important Portal Information**

Processed via a secure, role-based online application with a two-factor authentication system (Okta)

- Each user is required to have his/her own username/password and current e-mail address for access and receipt of notifications/alerts.
- Passwords must be changed every 90 days.
- Physicians must complete their <u>own</u> data entry





## **Registration Overview**

- Registration should only be completed if your practice was invited to the New IDEAS study by ACR staff.
- Practice registration is one time event to be completed by the practice administrator (overall access).
- Each user is required to have his/her own username/password and current e-mail address for access and receipt of notifications/alerts.



# **User Role Information**

• A user may have multiple roles in the study portal.

- 1. Create your account and click "Register."
- 2. Locate the 'Welcome to ACR ID' email in the email inbox you used to register and follow the one-time link to activate your account. Simply clicking on this link will activate your account (Note: check spam folder).
- 3. Return to the application's <u>home page</u>, and click "Login with your ACR ID" (purple Login button).
- 4. Type in your username (email address used to create ACR ID).
- 5. Set up Okta (two-factor authentication).
- 6. Return to the login portal and login with username and two-factor authentication.

Note: You will have to utilize a 'multifactor authentication' mechanism to log in each time. This is for security purposes.

Each Dementia Specialist Practice applying to participate in the New IDEAS Study must complete this web-based Pre-Registration Form to receive

a unique 4-digit Practice Number and to set up a Practice Administrator User ID. The Practice Administrator will then be able to complete the ful Registration Form. As a reminder, a **dementia specialist** is defined in the New IDEAS Study protocol (in accordance with the Appropriate Use Criteria for Amyloid PET) as a self-identified physician trained and board-certified in neurology, psychiatry, or geriatric medicine who devotes a

substantial proportion (≥25%) of patient contact time to the evaluation and care of adults with acquired cognitive impairment or dementia. Each participating dementia specialist Practice will enter into in a contractual agreement with the ACR that will ensure eligibility and facilitate payment for

The New IDEAS (Imaging Dementia—Evidence for Amyloid Scanning) Study is managed by the American College of Radiology and thus requires an ACR ID (username) to access the recently upgraded database.

Please read the following instructions before clicking on the study link below.

All users, including users with existing ACR IDs, need to sign up for a new ACR account to access the New IDEAS portal. Existing IDs do not work for the New IDEAS study. Click on "Sign up", then fill out the necessary information. Upon submission, you will be sent another automatic email to 'verify' your ACR ID. Do so by clicking the link in that email and login to the New IDEAS portal. To access the study portal at any time, navigate to the <u>study website</u> and click "Login" in the top right-hand corner.

Once logged in you should see your name in the top right corner. **Do not re-register your practice**. This has already been done. Instead, click on your name then click 'physician profile'. You will also be prompted to confirm your Board and Subspecialty certification, answer a few questions about your practice and upload a Human Subject Protection Course Completion Certificate. Click submit and wait to be approved by the ACR.

To access your site's registration page, click 'Practice Management' along the top.

Note: the link below must be used in order to connect your account to the correct site. This link expires after 10 days. Once expired, your site administrator will have to re-issue the link from their account.

# **Complete the Physician Profile**

### **Every Dementia Specialist added to the portal will need to:**

- 1. Click on the login link in the automatically generated email from the New IDEAS portal.
- 2. Create a **new** ACR ID with a unique email address and set up two-factor authentication.
- 3. Exit the ACR website and then login to the New IDEAS portal at <u>https://app.ideas-study.org/</u>
- 4. Use the site selection drop-down menu to select your site.
- 5. Click on their name in the top right-hand corner and select "Physician Profile"
- 6. Complete the following sections:

  - ✓ Upload Human Subject Protection Course Completion Certificate
  - ✓ Principal Investigator designation
  - ✓ Board and Subspecialty Certification(s)
