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**Diagnosis:**

LEFT FOOT SERIES, 5 images, Jun 04, 2012 02:32:59 PM.

CLINICAL HISTORY: Left foot pain.

DISCUSSION: AP, lateral, and oblique radiographs of the left foot are submitted for interpretation. There is a displaced intra-articular fracture involving the head of second left metatarsal bone with dorsal and superior displacement of the distal fracture fragment. Although no definitive extension through the physis is seen, this may be a Salter-Harris III type fracture. The remainder of the bones is unremarkable. There is no dislocation.

IMPRESSION: Displaced intra-articular fracture through the head of the second left metatarsal.
