YOUR CONSENT TO COOKIES

When visiting our websites for the first time, you will be asked for your consent to our use of cookies during your visit to our website. Please note, that Cookie settings can always be adjusted and changed via your own browser settings.

GENERAL INFORMATION

Cookies are data files that enable a website to collect and store data on your desktop computer, laptop or mobile device. They help us provide important features and functionalities on our websites and mobile apps. Cookies are used to improve your experience as a customer. Please note that our website may not work correctly without some cookies.

As an example, cookies help us to track which page you visit as you move through each stage of the ticket booking process.

Website analytics, like for example Google Analytics, provide us with statistical information about the number of visitors to our website and mobile apps but also about which areas of our website and mobile apps are most popular; they also allow us to draw conclusions on trends, for example if there is a particular page that attracts visitors from a particular country. These cookies generally help us to improve a visitor's experience when visiting our website.
