

W30A

Measure: Six or more well-child visits on different dates of service on or before the 15-month birthday.

Provider Tips:

- Target outreach to members who have completed 4 to 5 WCV's with your practice.
- Schedule visits ahead of time or schedule the entire suite of visits (six or more during the first 15 months) at the end of the first visit.
- Inform caregivers about the importance of frequent well-child visits during the first 15 months.

W30B

Measure: Two or more well-child visits on different dates of service between the child's 15-month birthday plus 1 day and then on or before the 30-month birthday.

Provider Tips:

- Target members who have completed their 12-month and/or 15-month WCV's with your practice.
- Make the most of any patient visit, healthy child or not, to educate parents on their child's health and provide children the needed health assessments, preventive care, and screenings.

WCV

Children and adolescents 3-21 years of age should have a well-care visit yearly.

CIS

Childhood Immunization Status Measure:

The percentage of children 2 years of age who had all combo 10 vaccines on or before their second birthday, including 2 doses of the flu vaccine.

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Note: Providers are mandated under Arizona Revised Statute (ARS) §36-135 to report all immunizations administered to children 18 years of age and younger to the state's health department via ASIIS (Arizona State Immunization Information System). If multiple immunizations are administered on the same visit, ensure that all immunizations are entered into ASIIS and also included on the claim.

If Immunizations are not provided in-office, refer patients to the county for immunizations.
