# Post Cerebral Vascular Accident (CVA) ICD-10 CM Diagnoses



A diagnosis and coding guide for medical providers and coding and billing staff.



During initial hospitalization for a new CVA, diagnosis is acute CVA until discharge.



Following discharge from hospital for acute CVA, diagnosis becomes a history of CVA, with or without residual deficit.



## **Diagnosis and Coding Tips**

- Following hospital discharge, member diagnosis becomes a history of cerebral infarction, Z86.73, or sequelae of cerebral infarction.
- Use history of cerebral infarction and/or sequelae of cerebral infarction for diagnoses in post-hospitalization skilled nursing facilities, rehabilitation, physical therapy, and office visits.
- Specificity in residual deficits is encouraged, e.g., identification of laterality.
- Reference the ICD-10-CM Handbook for instructions to know when additional coding is appropriate.
- If late effects of CVA have resolved, the diagnosis should be history of cerebral infarction without residual deficit, Z86.73.
