














SMART: Relevant


- Be honest with yourself, you know what you and your team are capable of.

My Engagement Plan

- Pick a season: Fall, Winter, Spring, or Summer
- **Pick a bucket:** Communications, Site Visits, Trainings, MB Topic, Site Reps, Other
- Identify the following:
 - Goal: SMART Goals (Specific, Measurable, Attainable, Relevant, Timely)
 - What: What are you going to do?
 - When: Be specific with month, day, time, location
 - Who: Audience, Presenters, Event Organizers
 - **Resources:** Be sure to include these in your budget planning process
 - Marketing: How will the event be promoted to ensure its success?







Evaluation

- Break down what you thought of the day:
 - Emmy Winner: Best thing I heard today?
 - Director's Cut: Don't know why we talked about this (be brutal!).
 - Rebroadcast: This is something I want my members to know.
 - Script: Other feedback that's on your mind.
