The CTA Death & Dismemberment Plan

The CTA Death & Dismemberment Plan is an automatic benefit available to eligible CTA members at no additional cost. This benefit provides the member, or to his or her beneficiaries, a lump sum payment in the event the member passes away or suffers an accidental dismemberment. The Plan provides:

- \$2,000 Death Benefit
- \$10,000 Accidental Death/Accidental Dismemberment (AD&D) Benefit
- \$50,000 Occupation/Association Leader AD&D Benefit

 If you pass away or suffer a dismemberment due to an accident or assault while at work or acting in the capacity of an Association Leader.

You may designate your beneficiaries by logging into www.CTAMemberBenefits.org and clicking on "Update Beneficiaries", or "Beneficiary Registration" (under the insurance tab). If you do not register a beneficiary, or if your designated beneficiary passes away before you, the Plan will pay the lump sum benefit in the following order:

- 1) Spouse, or Domestic Partner
- 2) Children, in equal shares
- 3) Parents, in equal shares
- **4) Siblings**, in equal shares
- 5) Executor, or Administrator
