Bringing Care Closer to Home in Northeast Wisconsin

As a sponsor of the Children's Wisconsin Open, you directly support the physical, dental, social and mental health of kids and teens. Every dollar raised at this event goes toward our exciting plan for a healthier Northeast Wisconsin. We're expanding on our long-standing commitment to bring care closer to home: Creating regional access to nationally ranked pediatric services, while reducing the travel burden for the children and families we serve.



New Clinics

We are thrilled to be providing access to more than 20 pediatric specialties at our clinic in Appleton (opened in 2023), which will soon be offering pediatric urgent care, and Ashwaubenon, which just opened in August 2025. These clinics serve as regional homes for specialty care and programs serving the Children's Wisconsin mission — and provide access to the largest, most comprehensive team of pediatric specialty providers and health care professionals in the region. In addition, we opened the Green Bay Mental Health Walk-In Clinic in September 2025, which offers mental health care to kids and teens experiencing urgent mental health issues. Each of these clinics is 100% focused on kids and provides state-of-the-art care to kids in Northeast Wisconsin.



Updated Facilities

The opening of our new clinics providing specialty services gives us the opportunity to update and enhance our existing hospital-based services, comprising a 22-bed, Level 3 Neonatal Intensive Care Unit (NICU) and a 20-bed pediatric inpatient unit. It also enables us to add a host of patient and family resources that support a more nurturing environment where families can find respite and connect with resources that empower, while also focusing on health and healing.



Expanding Programming

When children and families are strong and healthy, so are their communities. That's why we invest in programs that help kids cope with illness at our hospitals and clinics, as well as outreach programs and services that support kids and families at home and school.

New expanded programming in the Northeast includes:

- Child Life specialists that ease stress for children, caregivers and siblings
- Art and music therapies that provide a much-needed creative outlet and place kids on a path to healing
- Child advocacy and protection services that treat and advocate for children suspected to be victims of abuse, neglect and trauma
