

# **New Placement Timeline**

## Upon placement you should receive:

- o Orange Placement Folder- includes placement letter and healthcare insurance numbers
- o IA worker's information- Until TPC hearing where case is transferred (new detentions only)
- Family's contact information
- Child(ren)'s medical provider's contact information

#### In the first week:

- Complete a comfort call- This is best practice, and a great way to start building connections with the child(ren)'s family.
- 5 Day Visit- within the first 5 days after removal there must be a visit between the child(ren) and parents
- Temporary Physical Custody Hearing- (TPC) where a judge rules if the child(ren) is in need of protective services
- Case Transfer Staffing- occurs 5-7 days after TPC, it is most beneficial for you to attend this staffing to gain a better understanding of the reason the child(ren) came into care and goals for the parents.
- Apply for WIC (children 5 & under)
- Apply for Childcare Assistance- This will cover up to 35 hours per week of childcare, any hours needed beyond that you will need to discuss with your Family Case Manager for reimbursement.

## In the first 30 days:

o CANS rating- It is important that you discuss any behavioral/emotional/medical/educational needs with the Family Case Manager, so they are able to complete the CANS rating.

## In the first 60 days:

Schedule Medical and Dental checkups- check with Care4Kids

Things to have ready prior to placement, or quick access to:

- Car Seat
- Age-appropriate beds
- Diapers/Wipes
- o Books
- A handful of outfits
- Snacks
- Toys
