The Food Allergy Resources, Management and Support (FARMS) Clinic can help

Children's Wisconsin Asthma/Allergy Department is happy to offer extra support for your child with food allergies. This clinic will help with:

- Food concerns, safe food options, growth issues
- Daycare or school. This may include emergency care plans or 504 plans.
- Child or parent fear from food allergies
- Concerns about bullying because of the food allergy
- How to talk to your child about their allergy
- Money worries. You may have concerns about the cost of buying safe food.

FARMS Clinic meets 3 mornings per month at the Milwaukee Campus.

- 1st Monday of the month
- 3rd Friday of the month
- 4th Friday of the month

Ask your primary allergist doctor for a referral to the FARMS clinic. You can:

Note: This is a long visit that will last about 2 hours. The patient must be at the visit. Patients will be seen by all of these specialists:

- Allergy Doctor or Nurse Practitioner
- Medical Social Worker
- Health Psychologist
- Child Life Specialist
- Dietician
- Nurse Clinician

Please contact your insurance about coverage before scheduling:

- You may have to pay fees related to this visit.
- You may get a separate bill from both the medical provider and psychologist.
