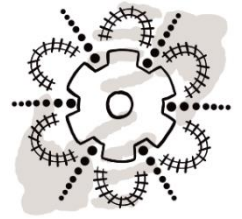


Bridge maintenance at Bloomfield Street, Kempsey

Community Notification

May 2026



UGL Regional Linx (UGLRL) operates and maintains the Country Regional Network (CRN) on behalf of Transport for NSW.

UGLRL will start scheduled bridge maintenance work at Bloomfield Street, Kempsey, in early May 2026.

What work are we doing?

We'll be carrying bridge maintenance work, including the installation of new deck boards, barriers and bridge components.

These improvements will help ensure the bridge continues to operate safely for all road and rail users.

To complete this work safely and efficiently, a temporary worksite will be established and a detour will be in place.

A range of equipment and machinery will be used throughout the work, including:

- cherry picker
- excavator
- mobile crane
- hand tools
- light and heavy vehicles.

When and where we'll be working

We'll be working at Bloomfield Street, Kempsey from **4 May 2026 to 27 May 2026**.

Work hours are **7 am to 5 pm**, each day for the duration of the work, including weekends.

What will this mean for you?

During the work, a **full road and bridge closure will be in place, including the bridge footpath**, from 4 May 2026 to 27 May 2026. **There will be no pedestrian access over the bridge during this time.**

For road users, a **2-kilometre detour** will be available via **Queen Street, Middleton Street, Macquarie Street and Bloomfield Street**, adding approximately **three minutes** to travel times.

You may also notice:

- traffic controllers and signage
- reduced speed limits
- footpath closure for the duration of the work
- additional workers and vehicles in the area
- some noise from machinery and equipment.

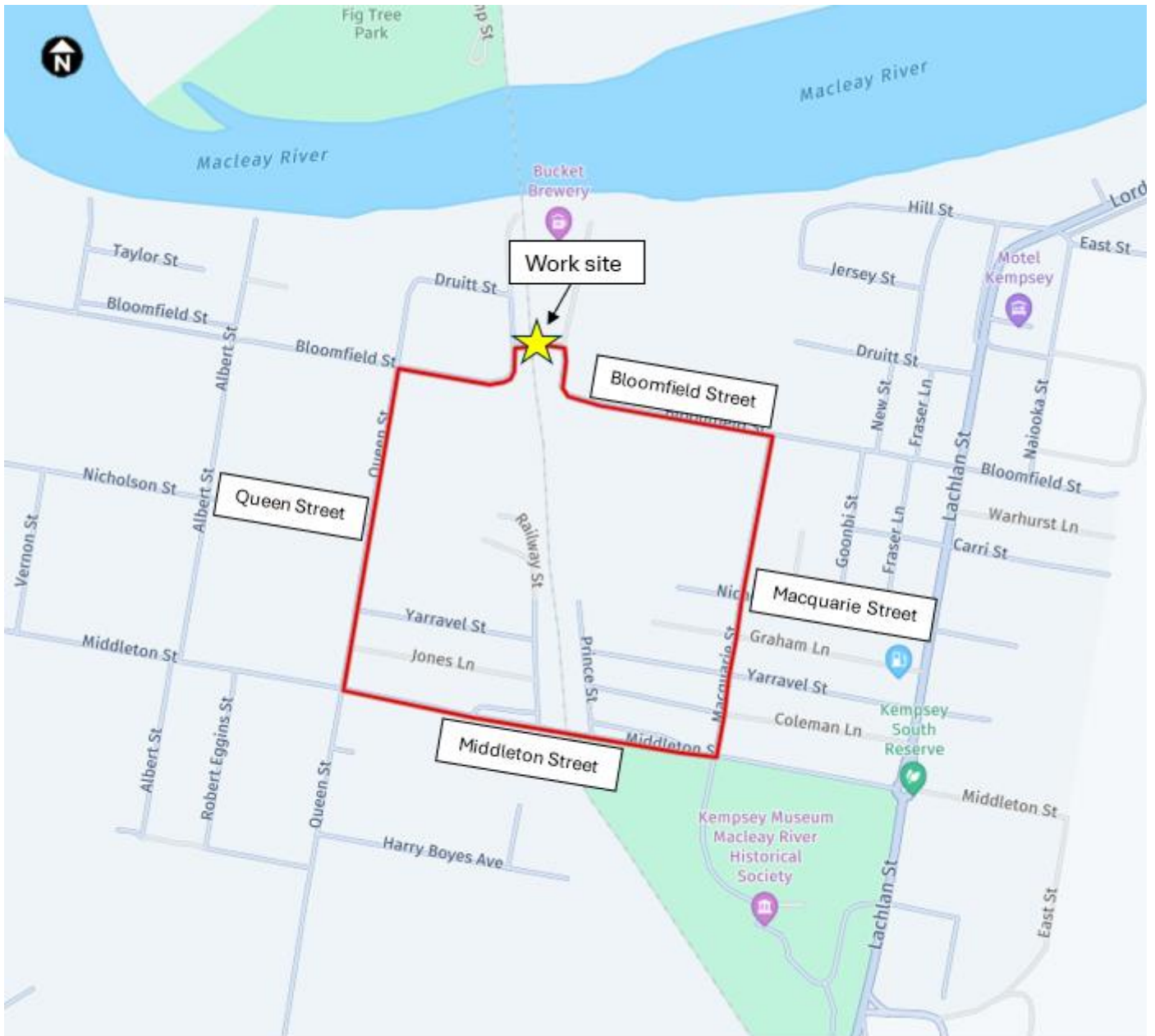
Managing our impacts

- installing fencing for safety and security
- reducing noise as much as practicable
- managing vehicle movements within the work area.
