## Level crossing repairs at Boree Street, Manildra

12 March 2026 to 16 March 2026

UGL Regional Linx (UGLRL) operates and maintains the Country Regional Network (CRN) on behalf of Transport for NSW.

UGLRL will commence repair work on the level crossing at Boree Street, Manildra.

### WHAT WORK ARE WE DOING AND WHERE?

The work involves repairing level crossing components to ensure access remains safe, reliable, and operational for the community and rail traffic.

### WHEN AND WHERE WILL WE BE WORKING?

- **Location:** Boree Street, Manildra
- **Dates:** 12 March 2026 to 16 March 2026
- **Hours:** 9am to 6pm

### WHAT WILL THIS MEAN FOR YOU?

UGLRL is committed to minimising the impacts of our work activities on the local community. During the work, you will notice:

- Road closure from **12 March 2026 to 16 March 2026**
- an 850-metre detour during the road closure available via Kiewa Street, Dederang Street and Yellowbox Road – see detour map over the page
- stop and go traffic control and electronic signage
- additional workers, machinery and vehicle movements in the area.

### MANAGING OUR IMPACTS

UGLRL will take all necessary steps to minimise community and environmental impacts. This includes, but is not limited to:

- turning off machinery when not in use
- instructing workers to keep noise to a minimum
- servicing machinery to reduce noise and environmental impact
- keeping the community informed of the road closure.
