## Level crossing renewal at Ellis Road, Gilgandra

21 June 2025 to 22 June 2025

UGL Regional Linx (UGLRL) operates and maintains the Country Regional Network (CRN) on behalf of Transport for NSW.

UGLRL will commence work on the level crossing on Ellis Road, Gilgandra, in late June 2025.

### WHAT WORK ARE WE DOING AND WHERE?

The level crossing will be renewed to ensure the rail line remains safe, reliable, and operational for road and rail traffic.

### WHEN AND WHERE WILL WE BE WORKING?

We'll be carrying out this important work at the level crossing on Ellis Road from **21 June 2025 to 22 June 2025**, between **7am to 5pm**.

### WHAT WILL THIS MEAN FOR YOU?

UGLRL is committed to minimising the impacts of our work activities on the local community. During the work, you will notice:

- a road closure from **7am to 5pm**, on **21 June 2025** and **22 June 2025**
- an eight-kilometre detour during the level crossing closure is available via Ellis Road and Maher Hill Road
- increased travel time. Please allow for extra travel time during the closure.
- additional vehicle movements in the area.

### MANAGING OUR IMPACTS

UGLRL will take all necessary steps to minimise impacts on the community and the environment. This includes, but is not limited to:

- turning off machinery when not in use
- instructing workers to keep noise to a minimum
- servicing machinery to reduce noise and environmental impact
- watering the area to control dust.
