Bridge removal at Bumbalong Road, Colinton near Bredbo

June 2026

UGL Regional Linx (UGLRL) operates and maintains the Country Regional Network (CRN) on behalf of Transport for NSW.

UGL Regional Linx (UGLRL), on behalf of Transport for NSW, is planning to remove the rail bridge located on Bumbalong Road, Colinton (near Bredbo).

To ensure public safety, removal of the bridge is planned from **Monday 17 August to Friday 18 September**, weather permitting.

WHY ARE WE DOING THIS WORK?

Inspections of the bridge have identified significant deterioration of the bridge, including severe rot, weathering and damage to key structural components such as trestles, girders and timber decking.

Due to the poor condition of the bridge, removal of the bridge is required to ensure public safety and reduce risks to the surrounding environment.

WHEN AND WHERE WILL WE BE WORKING?

We plan to carry out this important work during standard construction hours between **Monday 17 August and Friday 18 September**, weather permitting. There will be a temporary road closure on **Thursday 20 August between 10am and 2 pm**, weather permitting. The road will remain open outside these hours.

WHAT WILL THIS MEAN FOR YOU?

During the work, you will notice:

- Traffic control, speed restrictions and electronic signage to ensure the safety of all road users.
- Additional workers, equipment and vehicle movements in the area.

UGLRL will take all the necessary steps to minimise community and environmental impacts. This includes, but is not limited to:

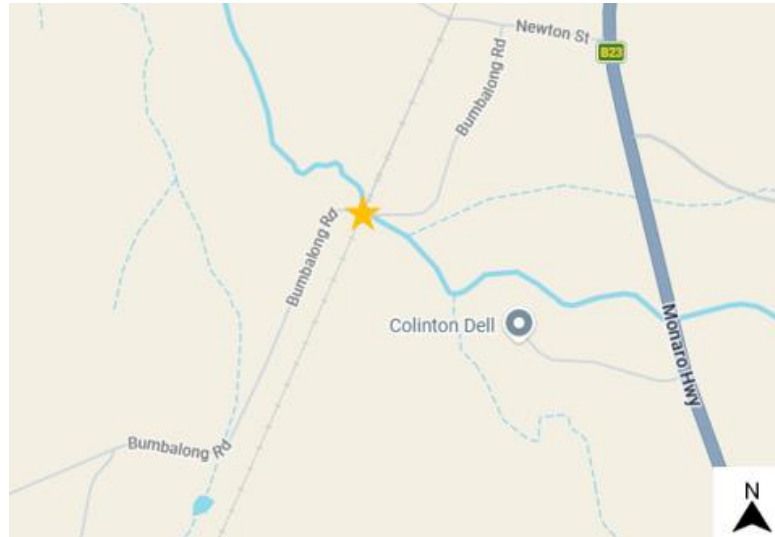
- turning off machinery when not in use.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Q: Why is the bridge work happening?

A: The non-operational rail bridge has reached the end of its functional life and no longer meets engineering and road standards. Its current structural condition poses a risk to the local community and environment.

Q: What kind of work is being carried out?

A: The existing five-span timber bridge will be removed to ensure public safety.

Q: Can you provide temporary access for pedestrians and cyclists?

A: There will be continued access for pedestrians and cyclists, with the assistance of traffic control.

Q: How long will the work last?

A: The work is expected to be completed between Monday 17 August and Friday 18 September, weather permitting.

Q: Will the road be fully closed during the work?

A: The road will remain open during the work, except on Thursday 20 August, weather permitting when it will be temporarily closed between 10 am and 2 pm. Outside of this short closure the road will remain open with speed restrictions and traffic control in place to help keep everyone safe.

Q: What are the alternate routes or diversions during the temporary road closure?

A: There are no detours or diversions in place during the four-hour temporary closure. Please plan accordingly.

Q: Will emergency services be affected?

A: Emergency services will not be impacted by the work and will be notified of the planned activities.
