Rail bridge renewal at

Wooyung Road, Crabbes Creek

May 2026



 Regional Linx (UGLRL) operates and maintains the Country Regional Network (CRN) on behalf of Transport for NSW.

We are writing to update you on the rail bridge renewal at Wooyung Road, Crabbes Creek.

In August 2025, UGL Regional Linx (UGLRL) consulted the community on the proposed construction approach and detour arrangements for the project. Concerns were raised about property access, the length of the proposed detour and the potential for isolation during flood events.

This feedback has been carefully considered and continues to guide the project team as we consider alternative options.

What work is happening?

In response to community feedback, the project has been paused to allow more time to investigate alternative options.

This work is focused on:

- better understanding community concerns
- reviewing access and detour arrangements during construction
- considering flood risk and potential impacts
- identifying an approach that best balances local community needs, safety and construction requirements.

UGLRL is working closely with Transport for NSW and other stakeholders to review all viable options. Community feedback will continue to inform decision-making, and no option will be progressed without further consultation.

What happens next?

Once an alternative option has been identified, the project team will update the community and seek feedback before moving forward. A second community hub (information session) will be held as part of this next stage of consultation.
