

Bridge repair on Olympic Highway, Wallendbeen

Community Notification

September 2026



UGL Regional Linx (UGLRL) operates and maintains the Country Regional Network (CRN) on behalf of Transport for NSW.

UGLRL will carry out bridge repair work on the Olympic Highway at Wallendbeen, in September and November 2026.

The September work will allow two-way traffic to return across the bridge while preparations continue for permanent repairs planned in November.

What work are we doing?

UGLRL will carry out a bridge repair to allow two lanes of traffic to operate across the bridge.

Work includes:

- repositioning safety barriers
- installing signs and line marking
- restoring the area to its original condition when our works are finished

When and where we'll be working?

We will be working on the Olympic Highway at Wallendbeen from **Tuesday 15 September** to **Thursday 17 September 2026**, and again from

Monday, 2 November to Wednesday, 11 November 2026, weather permitting.

Detours will be in place during both work period.

Working hours will be from **7am to 5pm**.

Further works will be carried out in November, we will continue to keep the community informed.

What will this mean for you?

You may notice:

- a **light vehicle road detour** via Silo Road and Burley Griffin Way
- a **heavy vehicle road detour** via Wombat Road and Burley Griffin Way
- reduced speed limits
- increased numbers of workers and vehicles in the area
- noise from machinery and equipment during the day

Managing our impacts

We aim to manage our work to avoid impacts to the community and the environment.

This includes:

reducing our noise as much as possible

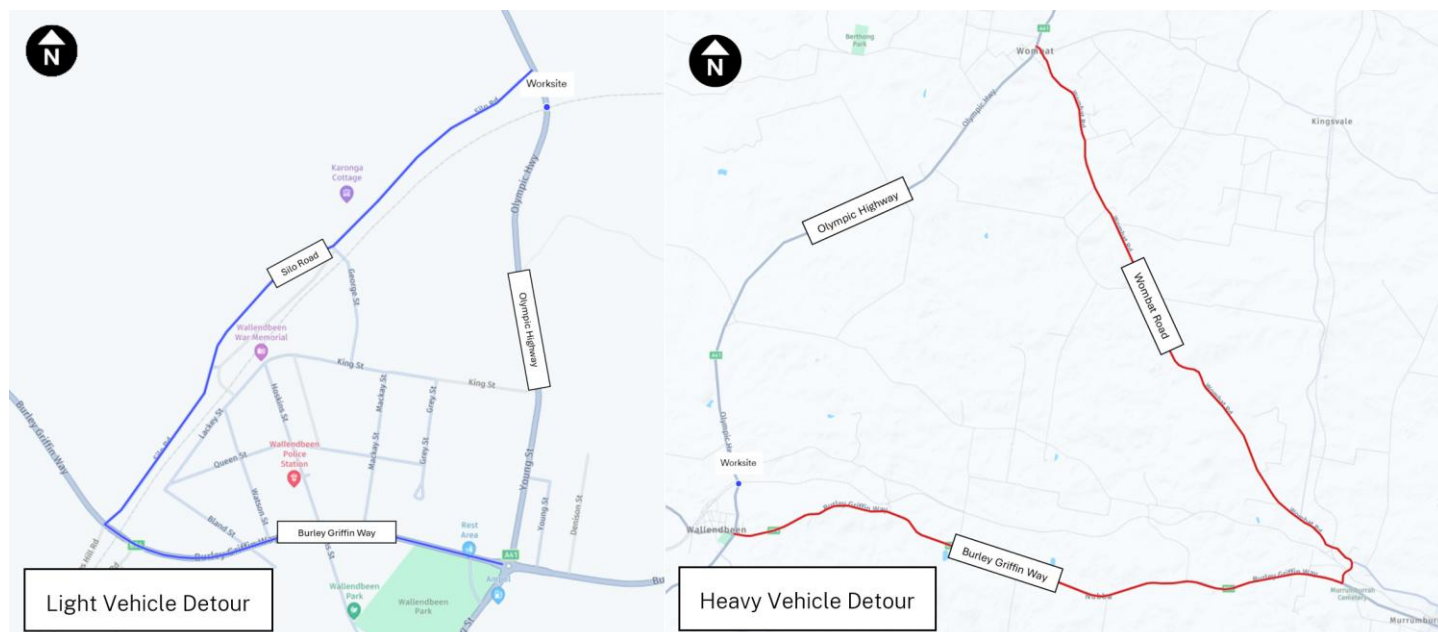


Location of work and detours

The maps below indicate the location of the worksite and the two detours in place from 7am Tuesday 15 September and 5pm Thursday 17 September.

Light vehicles will follow a 2.8 km detour via Silo Road and Burley Griffin Way with an estimated additional travel time of 4 minutes.

Heavy vehicles will follow a 31.3 km detour via Wombat Road and Burley Griffin Way with an estimated additional travel time of 21 minutes.
