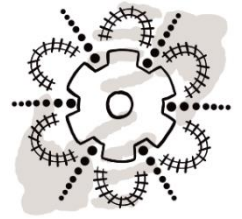


Extended bridge closure at Thurrung Street, Cooma

Community notification

May 2026



UGL Regional Linx (UGLRL) operates and maintains the Country Regional Network (CRN) on behalf of Transport for NSW.

UGLRL will start emergency work on the bridge at Thurrung Street, Cooma from 25 May 2026. The bridge will be closed to road vehicles however pedestrians and cyclists will still be able to use the bridge.

What work are we doing?

This emergency work is being carried out to ensure public safety as inspections have identified damage to timber components of the bridge.

We are working with Transport for NSW (Transport) and involving key stakeholders to determine the most appropriate solution in the long-term management of this structure. The bridge will remain closed while investigation and design activities are carried out. We will update the community once a preferred solution to reopen the transport link is determined. The bridge is expected to remain closed to road vehicles for up to two years.

When and where we'll be working

We'll be working at Thurrung Street, Cooma from **25 May 2026** from 7am to 5pm weekdays until further notice.

What will this mean for you?

You may notice:

- increased number of workers and vehicles
- some noise from machinery and equipment.
- A 3.9 kilometre detour via Thurrung Street, Wangie Street, Yareen Road, Polo Flat Road and Monaro Highway (to the north) OR a 2.7 kilometre detour via Thurrung Street, Wangie Street, Yareen Road and Monaro Highway (to the south).

Please plan your journey with expected short delays.

Managing our impacts

UGLRL will take all reasonable and necessary steps to minimise community and environmental impacts during the work. This includes, but is not limited to:

- fencing for safety and security
- reducing noise as much as practicable
- managing vehicle movements within the work area.

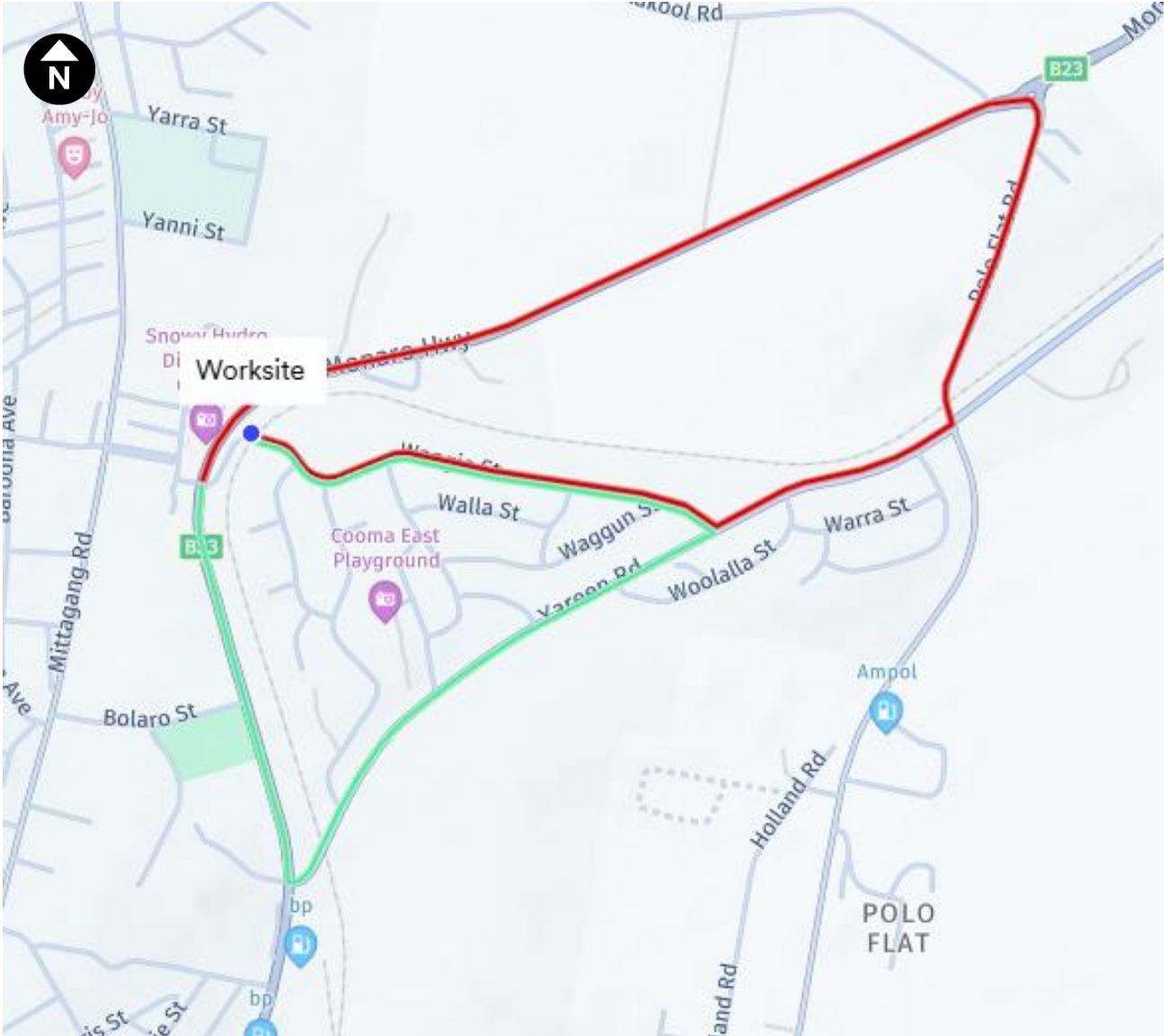

Location of work area

The blue dot indicates the worksite location on Thurrung Street, Cooma. The red line indicates the primary detour via Thurrung Street, Wangie Street, Yareen Road, Polo Flat Road and Monaro Highway three-kilometre and three-minute drive. The green line indicates the secondary detour via Thurrung Street, Wangie Street, Yareen Road and Monaro Highway with 2.7 kilometres and one-minute drive. Please note pedestrians and cyclists are allowed over the bridge during this work.
