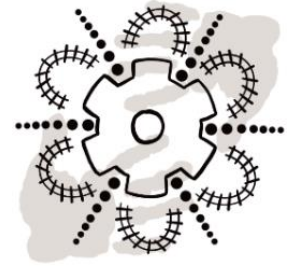


# Footbridge refurbishment at Orange Station

Community Notification

June 2026



Regional Linx (UGLRL) operates and maintains the Country Regional Network (CRN) on behalf of Transport for NSW.

UGLRL will commence scheduled maintenance work on the footbridge at Orange Station in early June 2026.

## What work are we doing?

UGLRL will be carrying out footbridge refurbishment work, including repairs to stairs and handrails, repairs to concrete and brickwork, replacement of damaged timber, and improvements to pedestrian safety surfaces.

These improvements will help keep the footbridge safe for pedestrians and rail users.

To carry out this work safely and efficiently, a temporary worksite will be established, and a detour will be in place.

## When and where we'll be working

We will be working at the Orange Station Footbridge from **9 June 2026 to 10 July 2026**.

Working hours will be from **7 am to 5 pm Monday to Friday** and **7 am to 3:30 pm on Saturday** with no work on Sundays.

## What will this mean for you?

During the work, the footbridge will be **fully closed** from **16 June 2026 to 10 July 2026**. Pedestrian access across the footbridge will not be available during these times.

A **600-metre pedestrian detour** will be available via **Peisley Street, Summer Street and Endsleigh Avenue**, adding approximately **10 minutes** to walking times.

You may also notice:

- signage in the area
- some noise from machinery and equipment
- additional workers and vehicle movements near the site.

## Managing our impacts

We will take all reasonable steps to minimise impacts on the community and the environment while work is underway.

This includes:

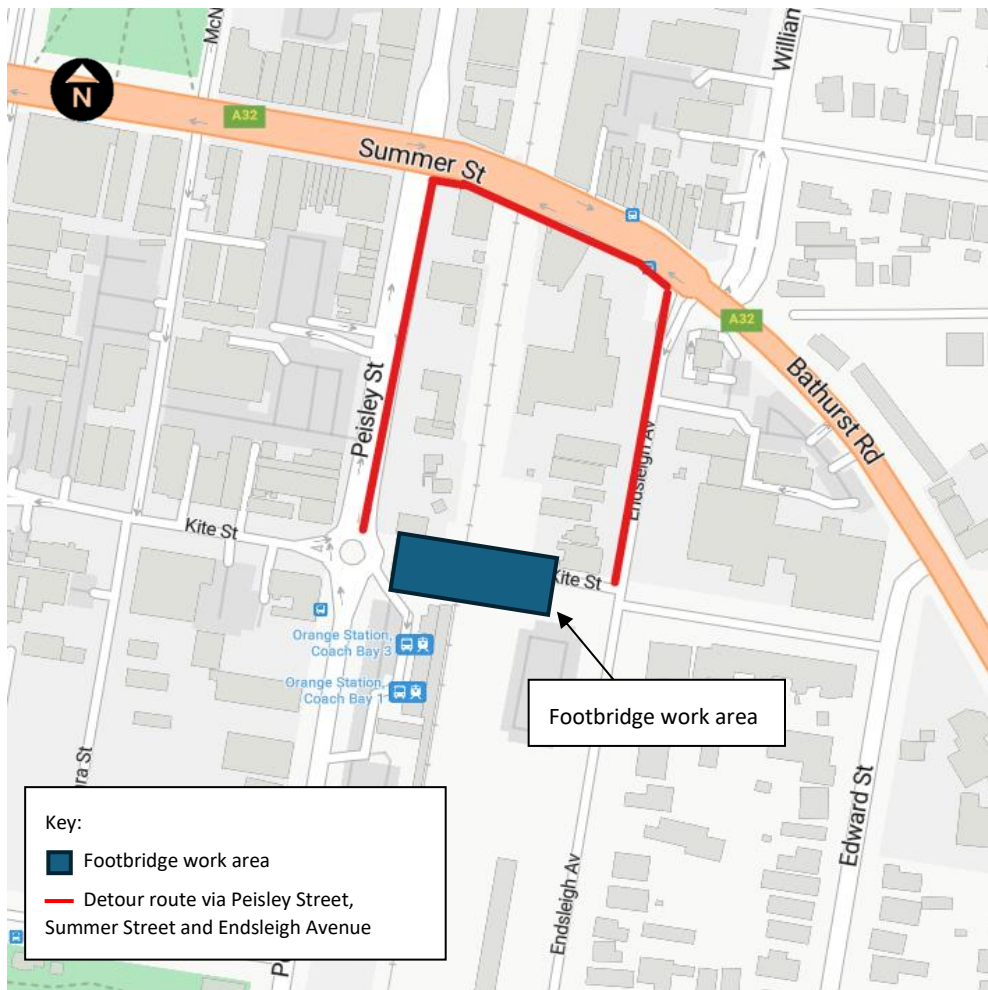
- reducing noise as much as practicable
- managing vehicle movements within the work area



## Location of work area

The yellow star indicates the footbridge site location near Orange Station, Orange.

The red line indicates the 600-metre pedestrian detour route via Peisley Street, Summer Street and Endsleigh Avenue, with an extended walking time of 10 minutes.
