

Level crossing upgrade at Archer Road, Mullion Creek

Community Notification

June 2026



Transport for NSW acknowledges the Traditional Custodians of the lands on which we work and pays respect to Elders past and present.

On behalf of Transport for NSW, UGL Regional Linx (UGLRL) is upgrading the level crossing at **Archer**

Road, Mullion Creek, between April and October 2026.

What work are we doing?

The level crossing at Archer Road, Mullion Creek, will be upgraded from a passive level crossing with signs and road markings to an active crossing with boom gates and flashing lights to improve safety. The work will be completed in three stages.

Stage one was completed on **15 May 2026**.

Stage two involves installing new cable routes for signalling, boom gate foundations and light masts, between **6 July 2026 to 31 July 2026**.

Stage three will commission and activate the new lights and boom gates between September and October 2026.

The community will be notified ahead of any work.

When and where will we be working?

We'll carry out this important work at Archer Road, Mullion Creek, from **6 July 2026 to 31 July 2026**, between **7 am and 5 pm**. Some work may be required on weekends.

What will this mean for you?

UGLRL is committed to minimising the impact of work on the local community. During the work, you will notice:

- stop and go traffic control
- digital signage
- increased vehicle movements in the area
- some noise from machinery

Managing our impacts

UGLRL will take all necessary steps to minimise community and environmental impacts. This includes, but is not limited to:

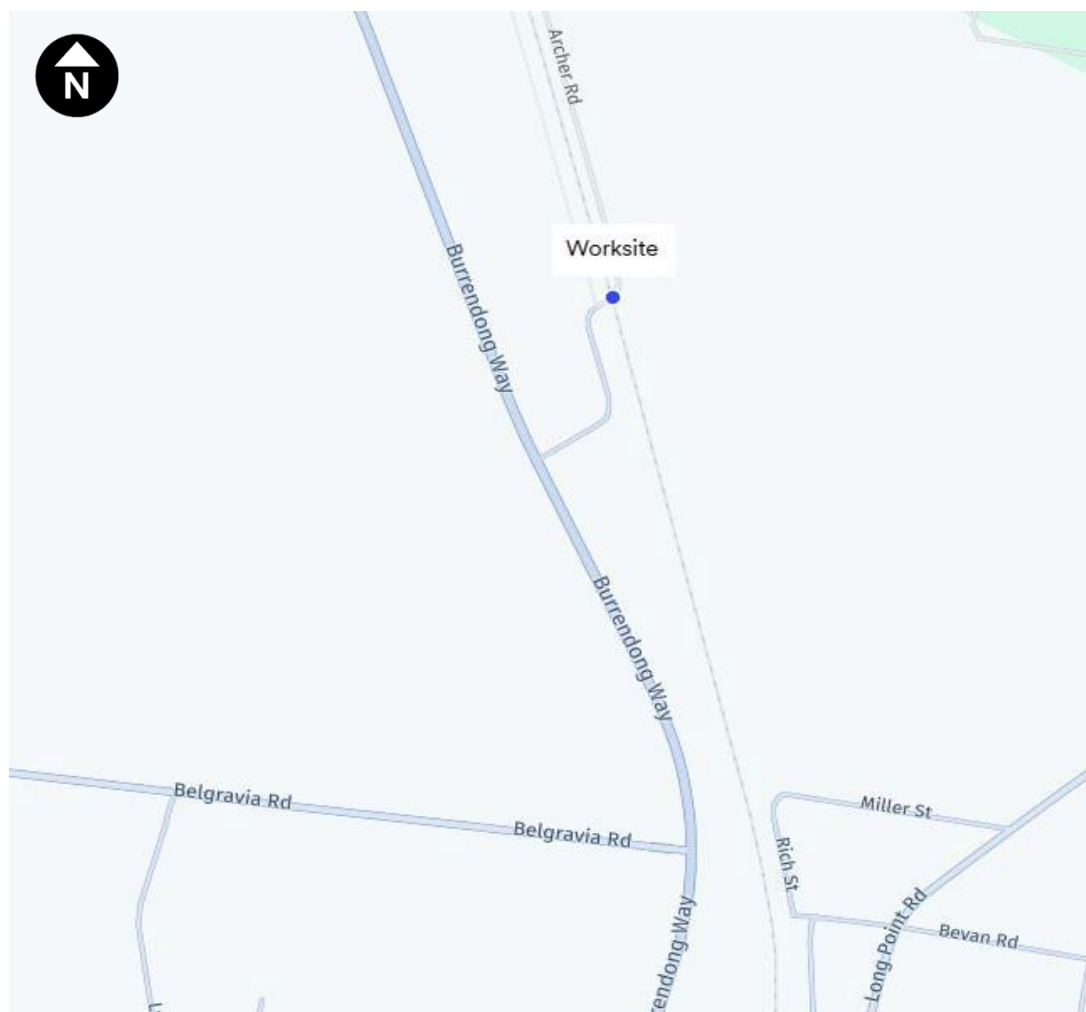
- turning off machinery when not in use
- instructing workers to keep noise to a minimum
- servicing machinery to reduce noise and environmental impact

Why we are doing this work

The Australian and NSW governments are jointly funding the upgrade of the Archer Road level crossing through the Australian Government's Regional Level Crossing Upgrade Fund (RLCUF) and the NSW Level Crossing Improvement Program (LCIP). This program will be upgraded to twenty-three high-priority level crossings in regional areas with high-intensity LED lights, bells, and retro-reflective boom gates to improve safety and reduce the risk of collisions and near hits.
