

Level crossing upgrade at Blumer Avenue, Griffith

Community notification

August 2026



Transport for NSW acknowledges the Traditional Custodians of the lands on which we work and pays respect to Elders past and present.

On behalf of Transport for NSW, UGL Regional Linx (UGLRL) is upgrading the level crossing at Blumer Avenue, Griffith, between August 2026 and February 2027.

What work are we doing?

The level crossing at Blumer Avenue, Griffith, is an active level crossing currently equipped with lights and signage. To further improve safety, boom gates will be installed as a part of the upgrade to the level crossing as well as new pedestrian safety barriers on the western side of the road.

The work is planned to be completed in two stages.

- **Stage one** will involve installing new pedestrian safety barriers, level crossing panels and boom gates from **Monday 31 August** until late November 2026.
- **Stage two** will involve testing and commissioning of the new level crossing in January and February 2027.

The community will be notified ahead of any work.

When and where we'll be working

We'll carry out work at Blumer Avenue, Griffith, from **Monday 31 August** until late November from **7am to 6pm**. Some weekend work will be required, including a continuous work period from **5am Saturday 12 September to 6pm Monday 14 September 2026** and from **7am on Monday 28 September to 3pm Sunday 11 October**. Work will occur during the day, evening and overnight. **Detours will be in place during this period.**

What will this mean for you?

UGLRL is committed to minimising the impact of work on the local community

You may notice:

- a temporary road closure at Blumer Avenue and a two-kilometre detour via Blumer Avenue, Wakaden Street, Crossing Street and Banna Avenue from **5am Saturday 12 September to 6pm on Monday 14 September** and **from 7am on Monday 28 September to 3pm Sunday 11 October**.
- increased vehicle movements in the area
- noise from machinery including a crane and other heavy vehicles.

Managing our effects on the community

UGLRL will take reasonable steps to minimise impacts on the community and environment. This includes:

- turning off machinery when not in use
- reducing noise as much as possible
- lighting directed towards the work site and away from residents.

Why are we doing this work?

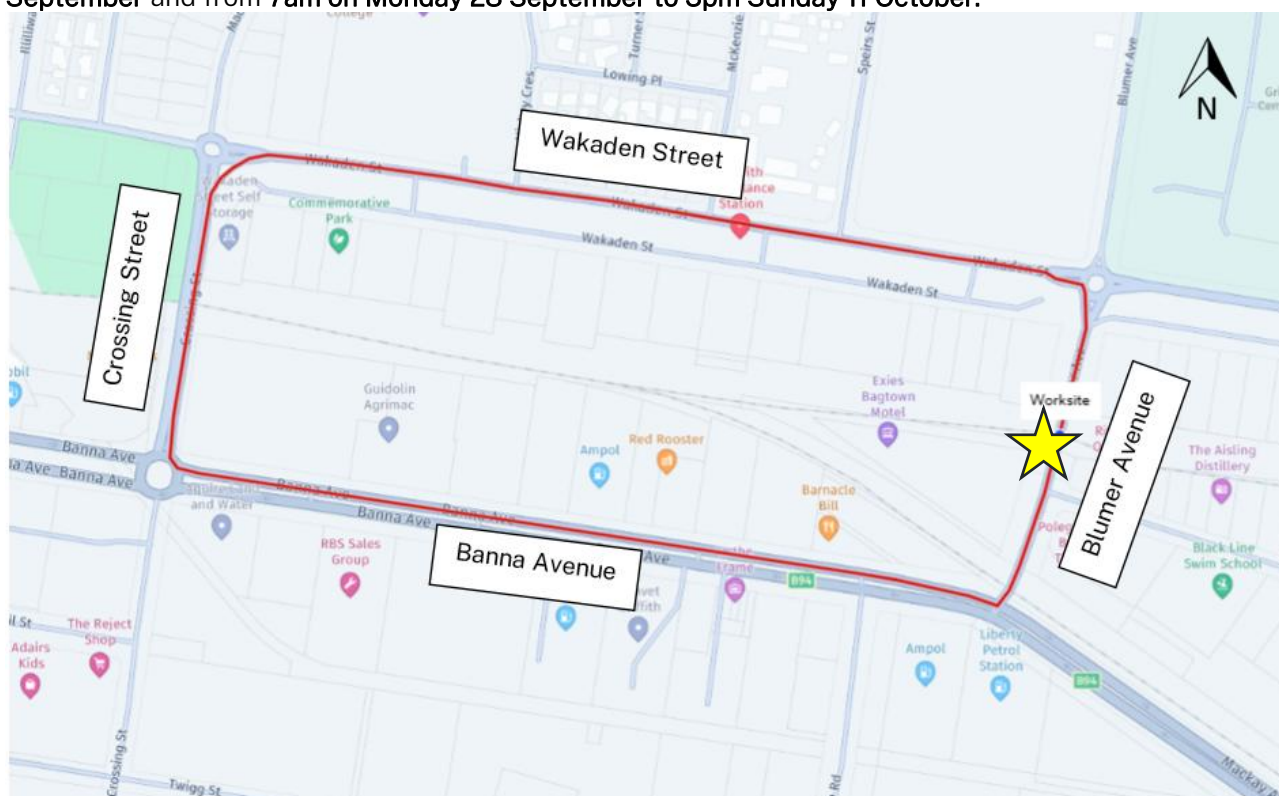
The Australian and NSW governments are jointly funding the upgrade of the Blumer Avenue, Griffith level crossing through the Australian Government's Regional Level Crossing Upgrade Fund (RLCUF) and the NSW Level Crossing

Improvement Program (LCIP). Together, these programs will upgrade twenty-three high-priority level crossings in regional areas with high-intensity LED lights, bells, and retro-reflective boom gates to improve safety and reduce the risk of collisions and near hits.



Location of work area
