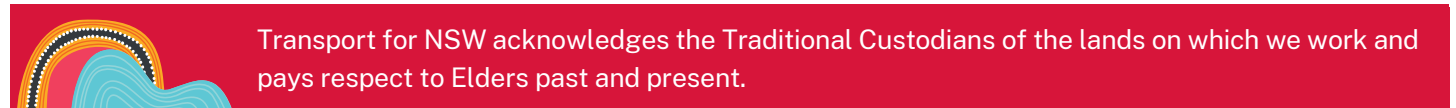


Level crossing upgrade at Markham Street, Armidale

Community Notification

August 2026



On behalf of Transport for NSW, UGL Regional Linx (UGLRL) is upgrading the level crossing at Markham Street, Armidale, with work continuing through to **September 2026**.

What work are we doing?

The level crossing at Markham Street, Armidale, currently has warning signs and flashing lights. To further improve safety, boom gates will be installed as a part of the upgrade.

The work will be completed in three stages.

Stage 1 involved installing concrete foundations for a new level crossing equipment building and signals, as well as underground cable routes. **This work was completed in August 2026.**

Stage 2 will involve completing the level crossing equipment building, installing new signals and boom gates, and carrying out testing of the new equipment. This work is scheduled from late August to September 2026.

Stage 3 will involve final testing and commissioning of the upgraded level crossing in September 2026.

We will notify the community before any work takes place.

When and where will we be working?

We'll carry out this work at Markham Street, Armidale from **Monday, 24 August to Monday, 28 September 2026**, between **7am and 5pm**. Some weekend work will also be required.

What will this mean for you?

During the work, you will notice:

- **traffic control** on Markham Street between **Monday, 21 September** and **Monday, 28 September 2026 from 6am and 6pm**.
- increased vehicle movements
- noise from machinery and equipment.

Managing our impacts

UGLRL will take all reasonable steps to minimise impacts on the community and environment. This includes:

- turning off machinery when not in use
- asking workers to keep noise to a minimum
- maintaining equipment to reduce noise and environmental impacts.

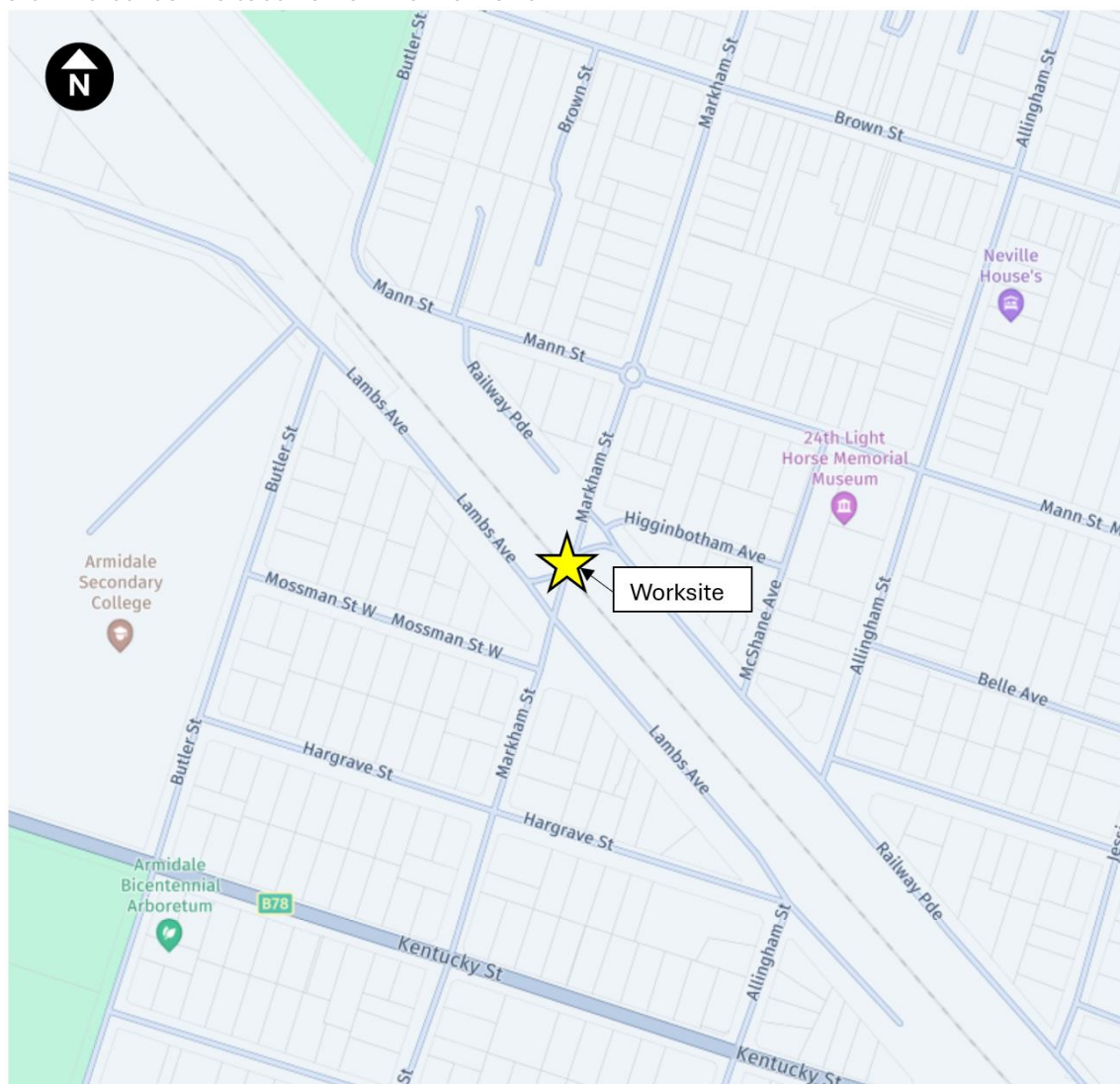
Why we are doing this work

The Australian and NSW governments are jointly funding the upgrade of the Markham Street level crossing through the Australian Government's Regional Level Crossing Upgrade Fund (RLCUF) and the NSW Level Crossing Improvement Program (LCIP).

Together, these programs are delivering safety improvements at 23 high-priority level crossings across regional NSW. Improvements include LED warning lights, bells and boom gates to help improve safety and reduce the risk of collisions and near misses.
