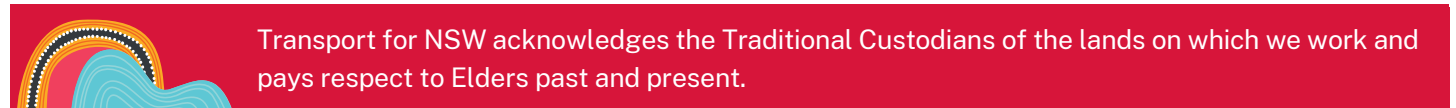


Level crossing upgrade at Markham Street, Armidale

Community Notification

June 2026



On behalf of Transport for NSW, UGL Regional Linx (UGLRL) is upgrading the level crossing at Markham Street, Armidale, between **June 2026 and September 2026**.

What work are we doing?

The level crossing at Markham Street, Armidale, is an active level crossing currently equipped with signage and flashing lights. To further improve safety, boom gates will be installed as a part of the upgrade.

The work will be completed in three stages.

Stage one will involve installation of concrete foundations for a new level crossing building and lights inclusive of cable route construction between **29 June 2026 and 19 August 2026**.

Stage two will involve completion of the level crossing building, installation of the new lights and boom stands, and testing of circuits and equipment between August 2026 and September 2026.

Stage three will involve testing and commissioning of the new level crossing in September 2026.

The community will be notified ahead of any work.

When and where will we be working?

We'll carry out this important work at Markham Street, Armidale, from **29 June 2026 to 19 August 2026**, between **7am and 5pm**. This will include some weekend work.

What will this mean for you?

UGLRL is committed to minimising the impact of work on the local community. During the work, you will notice:

- road traffic control on Markham Street
- increased vehicle movements in the area
- some noise from machinery

Managing our impacts

UGLRL will take all necessary steps to minimise community and environmental impacts. This includes, but is not limited to:

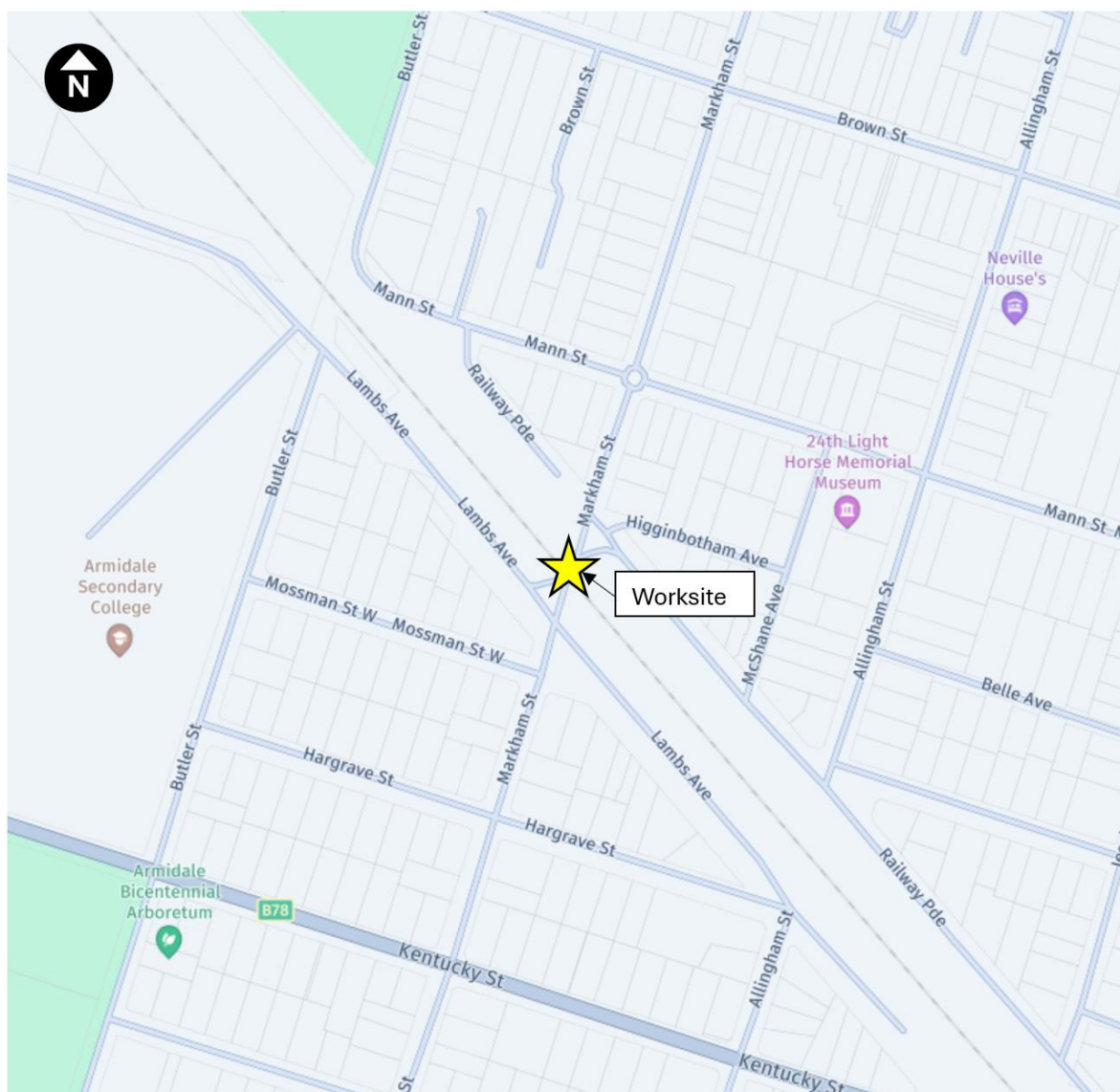
- turning off machinery when not in use
- instructing workers to keep noise to a minimum
- servicing machinery to reduce noise and environmental impact

Why we are doing this work

The Australian and NSW governments are jointly funding the upgrade of the Markham Street level crossing through the Australian Government's Regional Level Crossing Upgrade Fund (RLCUF) and the NSW Level Crossing Improvement Program (LCIP). Together, these programs will upgrade twenty-three high-priority level crossings in regional areas with high-intensity LED lights, bells, and retro-reflective boom gates to improve safety and reduce the risk of collisions and near hits.
