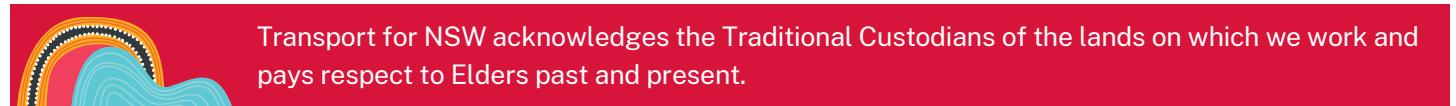


Level crossing upgrade at Mendooran Road, Brocklehurst

Community Notification

July 2026



On behalf of Transport for NSW, UGL Regional Linx (UGLRL) is upgrading the level crossing at Mendooran Road, Brocklehurst, between July and October 2026, weather permitting.

What work are we doing?

The level crossing at Mendooran Road, Brocklehurst, is a passive level crossing currently equipped with signage. To further improve safety, flashing lights, boom gates and bells will be installed as a part of the upgrade to an active level crossing.

The work will be completed in two stages.

Stage one will involve building a cable route and new concrete slab, between **Monday 27 July 2026** and **Sunday 30 August 2026**.

Stage two will involve the installation of the boom gates, lights and bells, as well as testing and commissioning of the new active level crossing between **Sunday 30 August 2026** and **Thursday 1 October 2026**.

The community will be notified ahead of any work.

When and where will we be working?

We'll carry out this important work at Mendooran Road, Brocklehurst, from **Monday 27 July 2026** to **Thursday 1 October 2026**, between **7am** and **5pm**, weather permitting. This will include some weekend work.

What will this mean for you?

UGLRL is committed to minimising the impact of work on the local community.

During the work, you will notice:

- increased vehicle movements in the area
- some noise from machinery

Managing our impacts

UGLRL will take all necessary steps to minimise community and environmental impacts. This includes, but is not limited to:

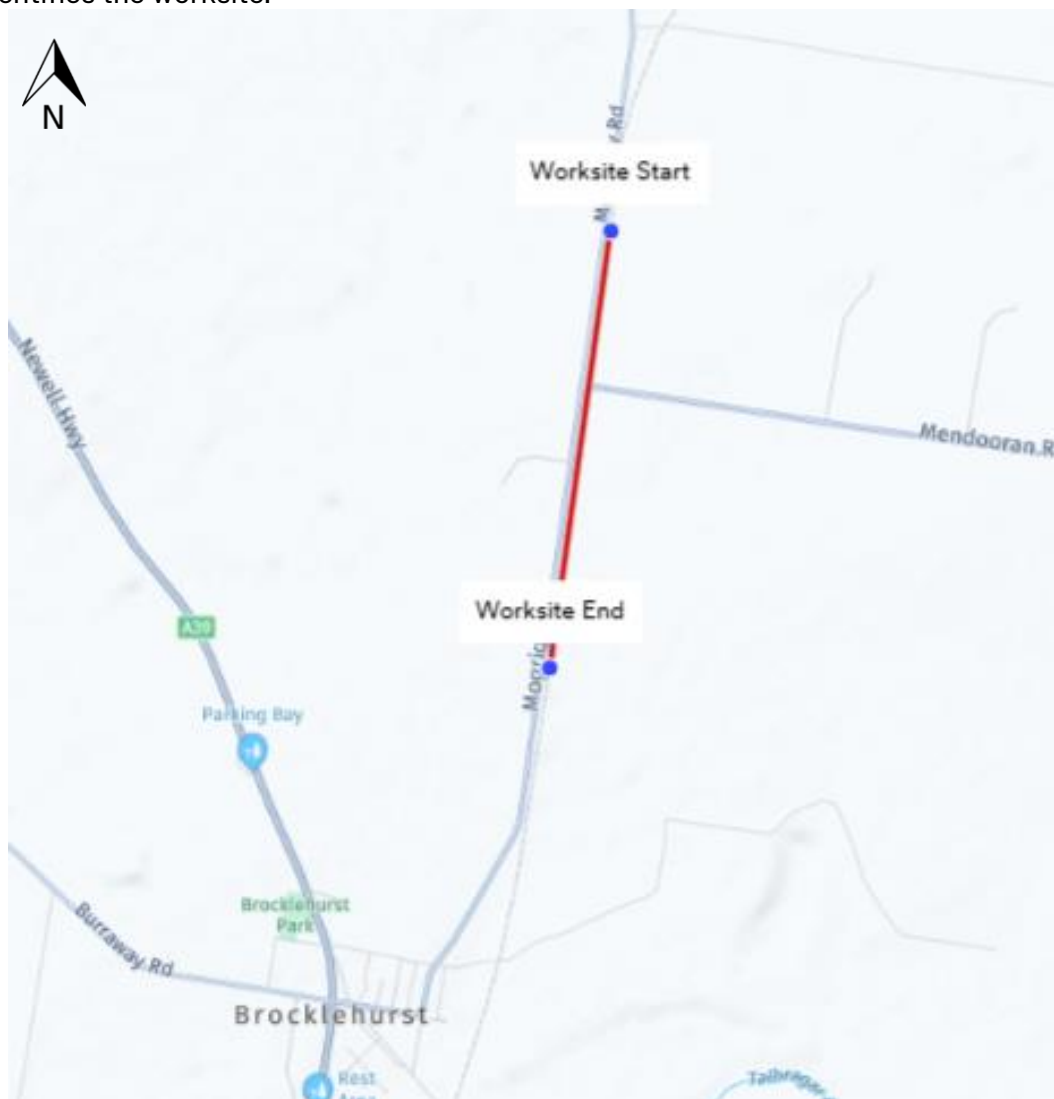
- turning off machinery when not in use
- instructing workers to keep noise to a minimum
- servicing machinery to reduce noise and environmental impact

Why we are doing this work

The Australian and NSW governments are jointly funding the upgrade of the Mendooran Road level crossing through the Australian Government's Regional Level Crossing Upgrade Fund (RLCUF) and the NSW Level Crossing Improvement Program (LCIP). Together, these programs will upgrade twenty-three high-priority level crossings in regional areas with high-intensity LED lights, bells, and retro-reflective boom gates to improve safety and reduce the risk of collisions and near hits.
