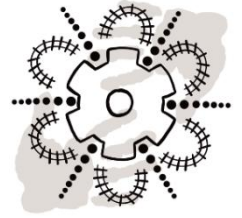


Rabbit Baiting at Old Junee

Community Notification

September 2026



UGL Regional Linx (UGLRL) operates and maintains the Country Regional Network (CRN) on behalf of Transport for NSW.

UGLRL will commence a rabbit baiting program in Old Junee from late September 2026.

What work are we doing?

UGLRL will carry out rabbit baiting to meet its responsibilities under the NSW Biosecurity Act 2015.

Work includes:

- installing warning signs at access points and boundaries of the area to be baited, before poisoned bait is laid
- laying of Pindone bait in approved treatment areas on the railway corridor
- inspecting treatment areas during the program
- collecting and disposing of accessible rabbit carcasses and uneaten bait.

When and where we'll be working?

We'll carry out this work at Old Junee from **Monday, 21 September to Tuesday 13 October 2026**, weather permitting.

Work will take place between **7am to 5pm**.

What this means for you

Please take the following precautions while warning signs are in place:

- do not enter the rail corridor for any reason
- keep children, pets and livestock away from the rail corridor
- do not handle bait or dead rabbits
- call the Poisons Information Centre on 13 11 26 immediately if a person swallows bait, or call 000 in an emergency
- contact a veterinarian immediately if you think a pet or animal has consumed bait or a poisoned rabbit.

You may notice more workers and vehicles in the area while this work is underway.

Managing impacts

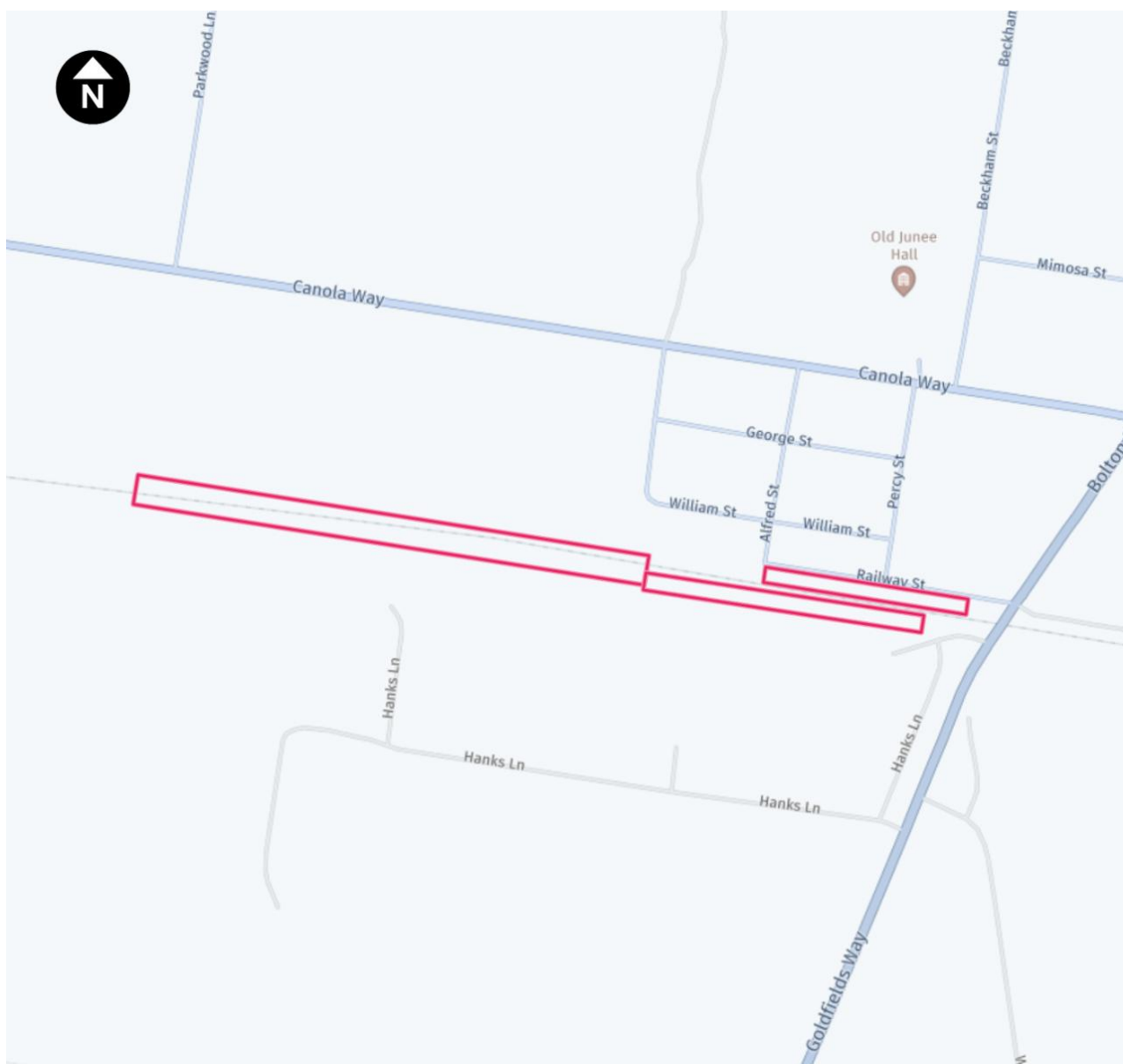
We'll manage our work to minimise impacts on the community and environment by:

- using appropriately trained and authorised personnel
- using approved bait products in accordance with the manufacturer's instructions
- following environmental requirements and NSW government regulations.
