

Track maintenance work between Orange and Dubbo

UGL Regional Linx (UGLRL) operates and maintains the Country Regional Network (CRN) on behalf of Transport for NSW.

UGLRL will carry out track maintenance work between Orange and Dubbo in September 2026.

What work are we doing?

We'll carry out maintenance work on the railway track to improve track condition and support the safe operation of the rail network.

Work may include:

- establishing a temporary work site
- carrying out track maintenance and resurfacing work, including ballast renewal and track levelling
- using equipment and machinery such as light and heavy vehicles, and hand and power tools.

When and where we'll be working

We'll be working between Orange and Dubbo from **Saturday 12 September to Tuesday 22 September 2026** between **7am and 5pm Monday to Friday** and **8am and 5pm Saturday and Sunday**, weather permitting.

What will this mean for you?

You may notice:

- additional workers and vehicles in the area
- noise from machinery and equipment.

Managing our impacts

UGLRL will take all reasonable and practical steps to minimise impacts on the community and environment during the work, including:

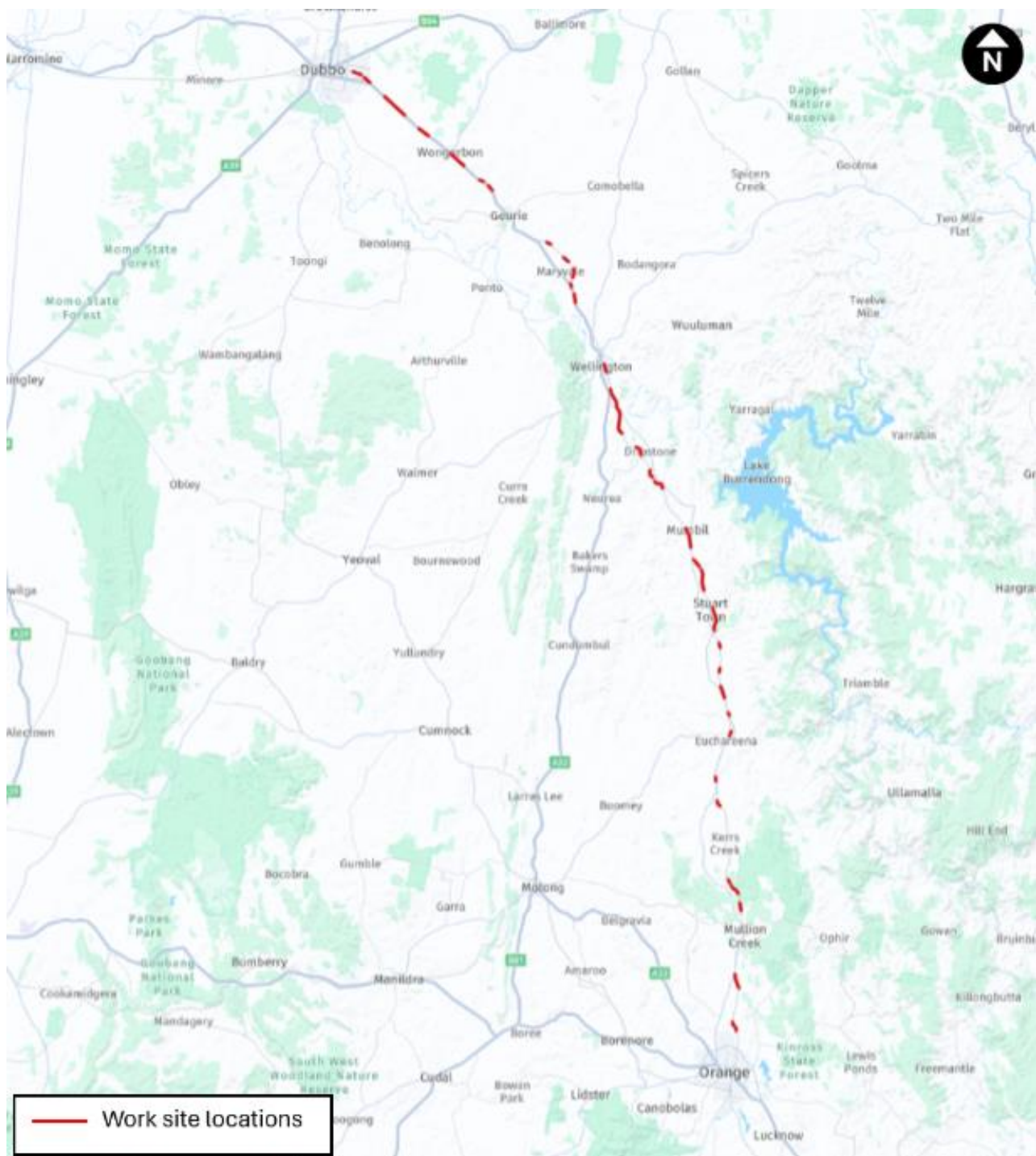
- reducing noise as much as practicable
