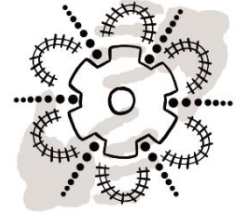


Signal maintenance at Cowabbie Street level crossing, Coolamon

UGL Regional Linx (UGLRL) operates and maintains the Country Regional Network (CRN) on behalf of Transport for NSW.

UGLRL will carry out scheduled signal maintenance work at the Cowabbie Street level crossing, Coolamon, in mid-June 2026

What work are we doing?

UGLRL will carry out signal renewal work to ensure the railway line remains safe and reliable.

Work includes:

- establishing a temporary work site
- fitting equipment to a new signal hut
- installing cables
- restoring the site when our work is finished.

When and where we'll be working

We'll be working at the Cowabbie Street level crossing, Coolamon from **13 to 17 June 2026**.

Working hours are **7am to 6pm every day**.

What will this mean for you?

You may notice:

- increased numbers of workers and vehicles in the area
- traffic controllers and signage
- noise from machinery and equipment.

Work will be contained to the rail corridor.

Managing our impacts

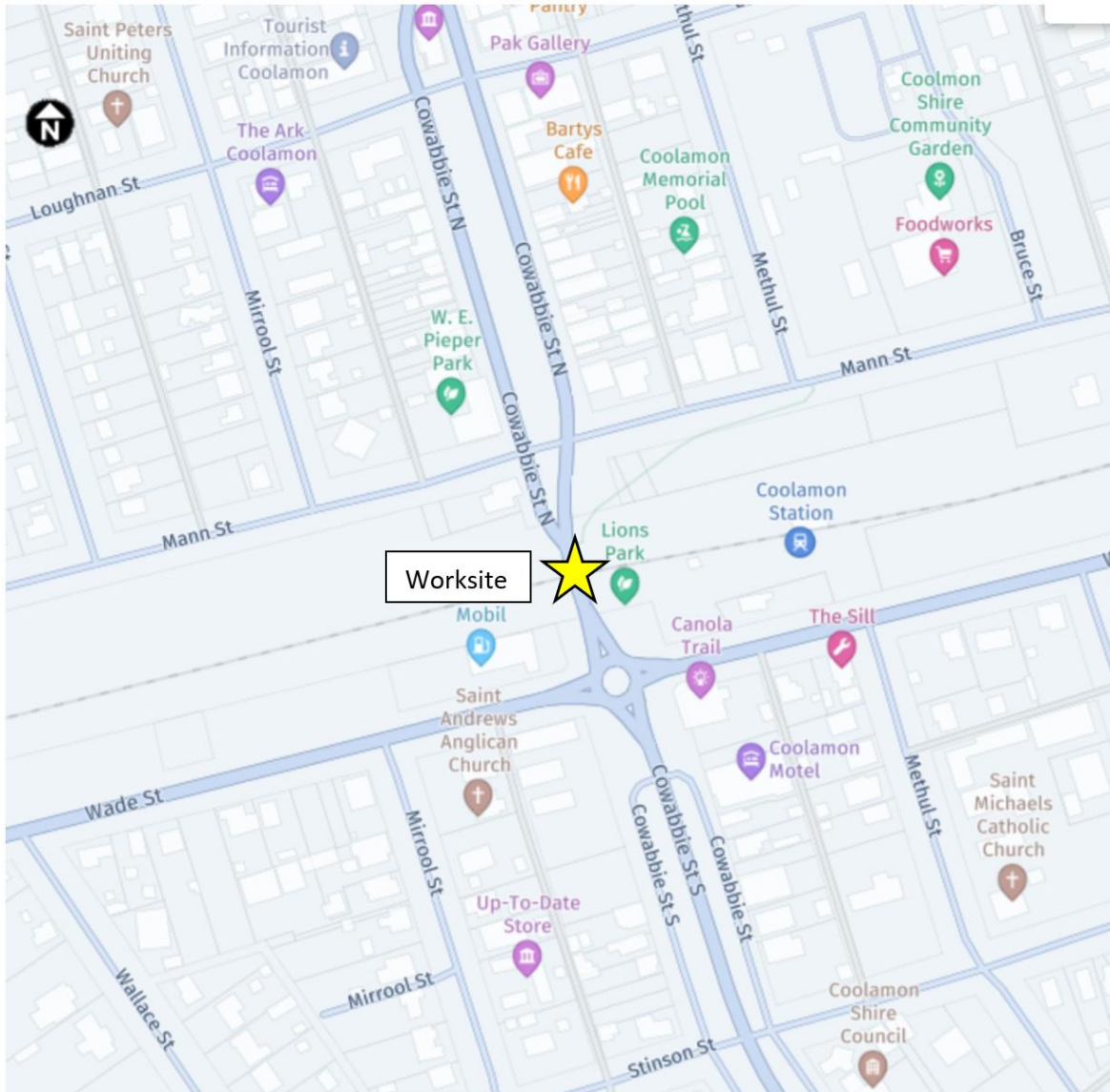
We aim to manage our work to minimise impacts to the community and the environment. The site compound is designed to minimise impacts.
