Pollution Incident Occurs **Definition of Pollution Incident:** "an incident or set of circumstances during or as a consequence of Employee/contractor/supplier to immediately notify which there is or is likely to be a leak, spill or other escape or person responsible for managing site deposit of a substance, as a result of which pollution has occurred, is occurring or is likely to occur. YES Contact Emergency Services Is there an immediate threat to human health or property? Call 000 It includes an incident or set of circumstances in which a substance NO has been placed or disposed of on premises, but it does not include an incident or set of circumstances **Notify Internal Key Contacts** involving only the emission of any 1.
