Notice of Application for Authorisation

CPB Contractors Ghella Joint Venture (CPBG) has applied to the Department of Infrastructure, Transport, Regional Development, Communications and the Arts to vary the Authorisation (number 01/2023) to discharge treated tunnel construction water, into Badgerys Creek at Western Sydney International (Nancy-Bird Walton) Airport. This activity is required as part of the contract to deliver the Sydney Metro - Western Sydney Airport, Station Boxes and Tunnelling Works.

This application has been made in accordance with Part 5 of the Airports (Environment Protection) Regulations 1997 (AEP) because chromium and zinc levels may be up to 10 and 8 times greater than the AEP Schedule 2, Table 1 accepted limits for these elements respectively. The authorisation is sought for the period to 30 September 2024.

CPBG has considered all reasonable and practicable alternate water treatment measures to prevent the generation of pollution from tunnelling and, where this was not reasonable or practicable, alternate disposal options to minimise pollution. This application is supported by an environmental management plan that includes soil and water quality monitoring to collect information on any effects to soil and water quality from the discharge and inform any required adaptive management measures, as well as reporting activities.
