



Does Your Child Need A Booster Seat?

Everything you need to know to keep your kids safe

Booster seats help raise your child so that the vehicle's seat belt fits properly. Unlike other child safety seats, they are not tightly installed in the car. Your child's weight will keep the booster seat in place.

YOU SHOULD USE A BOOSTER SEAT IF:

- Your child is **less than 4'9"** tall
- Your child **weighs less than 80-100lbs**

BEFORE YOU DRIVE WITH A BOOSTER SEAT:

- Always use a **lap and shoulder belt** when using a booster seat
- The vehicle's **shoulder belt should** rest on your child's shoulder or the collarbone
- The **shoulder belt should NOT** be under the child's arm or behind the back
