The Eating Disorders Clinic team is a professionally trained, multidisciplinary team that provides medical, psychological and nutritional services. Clinic services include evaluation, treatment and follow-up for children and adolescents ages 10-21 impacted by eating disorders. Counseling and guidance are also offered to their families.

*Family-based Treatment, sometimes referred to as FBT or the Maudsley Method, is a leading, evidence-based treatment for children and adolescents. FBT requires active participation by parents and guardians. The goal of FBT is to empower caregivers to nourish their children or adolescents by planning, preparing, serving and supervising all meals.
