

## Taking Your Baby Home from the Hospital

Everything you need to know to keep your kids safe

## MAKE SURE TO:

- Bring proper clothing to the hospital for the infant to go home in, such as a one piece garment
- The baby should NOT be wrapped in a blanket
- Use a rear-facing car seat with a 5-point harness appropriate for your baby's height and weight

## BEFORE YOU DRIVE AWAY:

- Make sure to use the vehicle's safety belt or the LATCH system to secure the car seat
- Make sure that the chest clip is at the infant's armpit level



- Make sure that the car seat is not reclined more than 45 degrees to keep the infant's airway open and allowing the infant's head to be in contact with the seat
- The harness should be placed at the infant's shoulders or below the shoulders
