

# KEEPING YOUR CHILD SAFE

## While Driving in Extreme Weather Conditions

Never leave a child alone

Temperature can rise 20° in just 10 minutes

Look before you lock

Set reminder about your child in the car

**IF YOU SEE A CHILD ALONE, TAKE ACTION**

1. Check on child, stay & call 911
2. Send someone to find parent or guardian
3. If unresponsive, get the child out

Clear off ice & snow

**IF STUCK IN SNOW:**

1. Run engine for 10 minutes every hour for warming
2. Crack a window and clean tailpipe

Wear multiple, light layers

**IF CAR SLIDES:**

1. Take foot off the gas
2. Turn steering wheel in the direction you want to go

**IF STUCK IN WATER:**

1. Get to higher ground
2. Don't ever go back into flood water
3. Call for help

Have emergency bag and kit

Avoid driving during flood watches & warnings

Avoid driving into standing water

Turn around, don't drown
