I. PURPOSE:

This policy outlines Children's National Hospital's (CH) position on the use of restrictive covenants and non-competition guarantees related to ACGME-accredited training programs and Trainee employment contracts.

II. POLICY SCOPE:

All Accreditation Council for Graduate Medical Education (ACGME) and Non-ACGME accredited residency and fellowship programs sponsored by CH.

III. <u>DEFINITIONS:</u>

Trainee

Trainee refers to all interns, residents and fellows participating in an ACGME or Non- ACGME accredited training program sponsored by CH.

Training Program

Training program or program refers to an ACGME or Non-ACGME accredited internship, residency or fellowship training program sponsored by CH.

IV. POLICY:

In accordance with ACGME requirements, CH, its Graduate Medical Education (GME) Office, and GME training programs prohibit the use of restrictive covenants and non-competition guarantees in any Trainee employment contract. This includes the official contract offered by the GME Office as well as any communications from the training programs.
