#### Welcome to Children's National!






Inside the hospital, I go to the welcome desk. My parents get a sticker. Now, I go to the Cardiology Clinic.







# I take the elevator to the 3<sup>rd</sup> floor to the Cardiac Clinic. Cardiac means heart.

I step on the scale to check my weight. I stand still all by myself.







The nurse measures my height. I stand tall and still. If I am nervous, I can hold my parents' hand.






#### I go to the ECHO room.










I lie down to start my ECHO. The ECHO test shows how my heart beats.
