

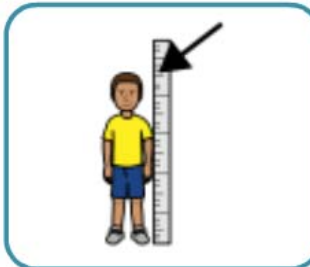
Visual Schedule: Vital Signs

First, I go to the Doctor's office. I can listen to music, hold my parent's hand, or hold my favorite toy.

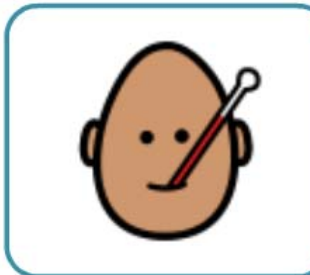
When I get to the doctor's office, I wait in the waiting room. I listen for the nurse to call my name. My parents and I go with the nurse.
