
Neonatal Therapeutic Cooling Program

Inclusions and Exclusions

- ≥ 36 weeks gestation
- > 1,800 grams at birth
- < 6 hours of age</pre>

Exclude: severe chromosomal or other anomalies, extremis/nonintervention



NEUROLOGIC EXAM CRITERIA

Moderate or severe encephalopathy is demonstrated by the following.

Moderate encephalopathy has three of six findings below:

- 1. Lethargic
- 2. Inactive, decreased activity
- 3. Flexion/extension posture
- 4. Hypotonia focal or general
- 5. Weak suck/incomplete Moro
- 6. Pupils constricted, bradycardia, periodic breathing

OR

Severe encephalopathy has three of six findings below:

- 1. Stupor/coma
- No activity
- Decerebrate
- 4. Flaccid tone
- 5. Absent suck/Moro
- 6. Pupils dilated/unreactive/ skew, variable HR, apnea

OR

Any seizure witnessed by a reliable observer.
