

Referring Patients for Imaging at Children's National during Coronavirus Pandemic

Children's National Hospital has instituted protocols to ensure that febrile patients are directed right to intended place of service. Radiology is open and available for chest x-rays for acutely ill children who do not need ER evaluation, and for other imaging.

Here is what patients should expect on arrival:

- o Advise patients to arrive between 8 a.m. and 4 p.m.
- o Check in at Welcome Desk where they will be assigned an escort to take them to re-purposed Genetics Clinic for a screening, including temperature.
- o From screening, the patient will be escorted to radiology and brought directly to a room in radiology for imaging.
- o Symptomatic patients arriving outside of the 8 a.m. and 4 p.m. window will be referred to the ED.

Other Children's National imaging sites with simpler screening procedures are listed below. For febrile patients, please call ahead to these sites so that they can be prepared to manage appropriately.
